RE: Notice of Land Application of Effluent

Dear Water User:

The Department of Water Resources acknowledges the receipt of your Notice of Land Application of Effluent for H. J. Grathol, a California General Partnership.

Idaho Code § 42-201(8) requires municipalities, municipal providers, sewer districts and regional public entities operating treatment works to notify the Department when land application of effluent is to take place on land not identified as a place of use for an existing irrigation water right. Since you do not meet these criteria, the Department is returning your application and refunding the filing fee.

Also, you do not need a water right in your name for the practice of applying effluent to irrigate landscaping. The source of the effluent is originally diverted under the City of Athol's municipal rights. Landscape irrigation is authorized under the City of Athol's municipal rights. Your application for permit, 95-17902, is still needed to use ground water from your private well for irrigation purposes until your effluent is established. Application for permit 95-17902 is being evaluated by staff in our Northern Region Office.

Dear Mr. Hayes:

The Department of Water Resources (Department) received a Notice of Land Application of Effluent from HJ Grathol on November 4, 2019. During the review of this application, the Department has a few issues that need clarification. An email (attached) was sent to you on November 4, 2019, but as of the date of this letter, no response has been received.

The questions that need clarification are:

- 1. Where does the wastewater originate from before it goes into the septic system? Are their facilities on-site that the water drains into the septic system?
- 2. Are you land applying because a state or federal entity is requiring you to do so? Is this a state or federal regulatory requirement?
