On May 10, 2019, Calvin and Susie Low filed Application for Permit no. 57-12005 with the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department"). Thomas DeShazo and/or Castle Creek Ranch LLC protested the applications.

Thomas DeShazo and/or Castle Creek Ranch LLC are in default and their protest is **DISMISSED** and will not be further considered in the above captioned matter by the Department.

RIGHT TO CHALLENGE

Pursuant to Rule 701 of the Department's Rules of Procedure (IDAPA 30.01.01.701), the protestant Thomas DeShazo has seven (7) days after the service of this *Notice of Proposed Default Order* to file a written petition requesting that a default order not be issued. Service is complete three days following the date of mailing this *Notice of Proposed Default Order* as set forth in the Certificate of Service. The petition must state the grounds why the petitioning party believes that a default order should not be issued.
