





EXPLANATORY INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY A PRELIMINARY ORDER

(To be used in connection with actions when a hearing was **not** held)

(Required by Rule of Procedure 730.02)

The accompanying order or approved document is a "Preliminary Order" issued by the department pursuant to section 67-5243, Idaho Code. <u>It can and will become a final order without further action of the Department of Water Resources ("department") unless a party petitions for reconsideration, files an exception and brief, or requests a hearing as further described below:</u>

PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of a preliminary order with the department within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. **Note:** the petition must be <u>received</u> by the department within this fourteen (14) day period. The department will act on a petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See Section 67-5243(3) Idaho Code.

EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEFS

Within fourteen (14) days after: (a) the service date of a preliminary order, (b) the service date of a denial of a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, any party may in writing support or take exceptions to any part of a preliminary order and may file briefs in support of the party's position on any issue in the proceeding with the Director. Otherwise, this preliminary order will become a final order of the agency.

If the Director grants a petition to review the preliminary order, the Director shall allow all parties an opportunity to file briefs in support of or taking exceptions to the preliminary order and may schedule oral argument in the matter before issuing a final order. If oral arguments are to be heard, the Director will within a reasonable time period notify each party of the place, date and hour for the argument of the case. Unless the Director orders otherwise, all oral arguments will be heard in Boise, Idaho.

CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE

All exceptions, briefs, requests for oral argument and any other matters filed with the Director in connection with the preliminary order shall be served on all other parties to the proceedings in accordance with IDAPA Rules 37.01.01302 and 37.01.01303 (Rules of Procedure 302 and 303).

FINAL ORDER

The Director will issue a final order within fifty-six (56) days of receipt of the written briefs, oral argument or response to briefs, whichever is later, unless waived by the parties or for good cause shown. The Director may remand the matter for further evidentiary hearings if further factual development of the record is necessary before issuing a final order. The department will serve a copy of the final order on all parties of record.

Section 67-5246(5), Idaho Code, provides as follows:

Unless a different date is stated in a final order, the order is effective fourteen (14) days after its service date if a party has not filed a petition for reconsideration. If a party has filed a petition for reconsideration with the agency head, the final order becomes effective when:

- (a) The petition for reconsideration is disposed of; or
- (b) The petition is deemed denied because the agency head did not dispose of the petition within twenty-one (21) days.

APPEAL OF FINAL ORDER TO DISTRICT COURT

Pursuant to sections 67-5270 and 67-5272, Idaho Code, if this preliminary order becomes final, any party aggrieved by the final order or orders previously issued in this case may appeal the final order and all previously issued orders in this case to district court by filing a petition in the district court of the county in which:

- i. A hearing was held,
- ii. The final agency action was taken,
- iii. The party seeking review of the order resides, or
- iv. The real property or personal property that was the subject of the agency action is located.

The appeal must be filed within twenty-eight (28) days of this preliminary order becoming final. See section 67-5273, Idaho Code. The filing of an appeal to district court does not itself stay the effectiveness or enforcement of the order under appeal.

Re: Evaluation of Sufficiency of Information Submitted

Application proposes transferring a 10.0 acre portion (0.19 cfs) of six groundwater irrigation rights from a farm located approximately 2.8–3.4 miles east and 4.3–6.5 miles south of Malta to commercial and stockwater use at an existing dairy located 3.4–3.6 miles east and 8.3–8.6 miles south of Malta. The application also proposes to update the legal description of the authorized point of diversion for the domestic and stockwater right currently utilized at the dairy site. The irrigated portion (0.19 cfs) being transferred plus the domestic and stockwater right (0.24 cfs) total of 0.43 cfs will be diverted from the existing well at the dairy site. The volume for the domestic and stockwater right was determined by information provided by the applicant and by using department standards of 0.6 af for three homes which equals 1.8 af and 4 af/acre for 0.5 acres which equals 2.0 af, for a total 3.8 af for domestic and 10.8 af for stockwater, totaling 14.6 af.

The irrigation to commercial and stockwater use conversion was based on an acre to volume conversion factor of 2.64 af/acre taken from the University of Idaho precipitation deficit volumes averaged for alfalfa (5 acres, 3.15 af/a) and wheat (5 acres, 2.13 af/a) total 10.0 acres for the Malta area. This was based on information received from the USDA that alfalfa and wheat have been grown on the farm. The wells involved with the transfer are located outside of the ESPA smooth model boundary area so a ground water model analysis was not required. The transfer's proposed changes are within Water District 143, therefore watermaster comments were sought and the watermaster gave his consent to approval of this transfer

Application was subject to notice and protest. No protests were received.

Authority to File:

The applicant provided a contract for sale of water rights agreement for this transfer. A special warranty deed from J7, LLC to Smith Brothers Jerseys, LLC for the water rights will be executed after approval of this transfer. A notice of change in water right ownership will be filed to change the ownership from J7, LLC to Smith Brothers Jerseys, LLC

Water Right Validity:

The water rights involved in this transfer were decreed in 2002. Current aerial photography indicates that the water rights have been used in recent years.

Injury to Other Water Rights:

None anticipated. The transfer will result in a reduction in the diversion volume based on the conversion factor from the crop analysis.

• Enlargement of Use:

None anticipated.

Local Public Interest:

No negative impacts anticipated. Application was subject to notice and protest. No protest were received. Watermaster comments were solicited and the watermaster did not oppose the approval of this application.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources:
