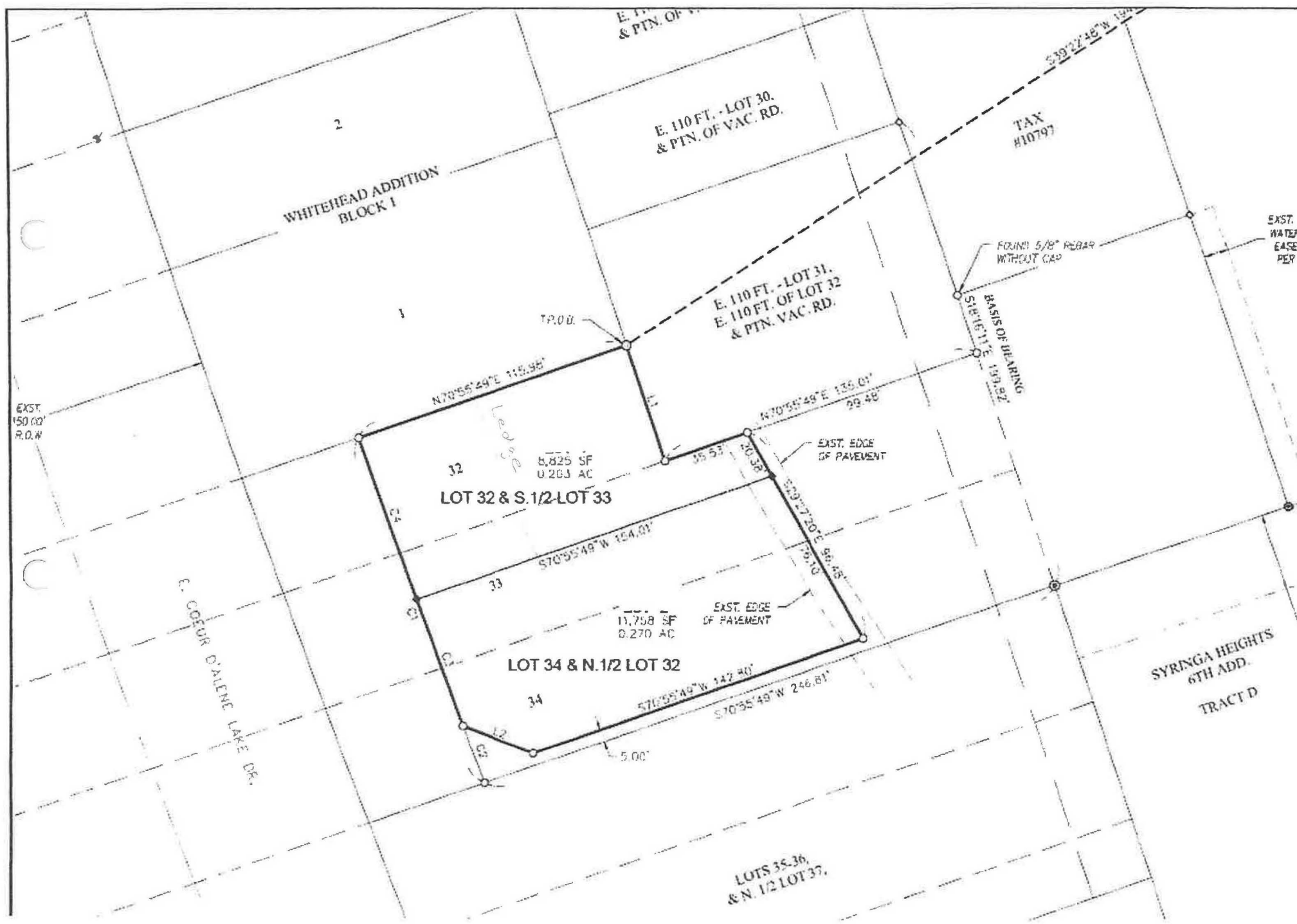

Dear Mrs. Clark,

I am writing in response to your letter of May 1, 2019 on behalf of Silver Beach 31-41 Association, Inc.

First of all, congratulations on your purchase and future plans.

At present, the Corporation's water system is functional and has not suffered any substantial operational issues in the last year or so. While it would be nice to upgrade the system, such is not required at this juncture.

As I understand, you are seeking two additional connections to the Corporation's existing water system to accommodate two homes you intend to develop in the future. It is my understanding, the existing system is not capable of handling, nor designed for two additional connections. Ergo, if two additional connections were to be allowed, such would require upgrading the system. While an upgraded system would be nice, respectfully, the Corporation is not required to provide any additional connections, nor incur the cost of upgrading its existing system to allow for such. Especially, given the present lack of need for an upgrade. If you would like additional connections, if possible, and an upgraded system, you will most likely need to make a substantial contribution to cover such cost.

If you would like to make an offer to the Corporation relevant to the costs you are willing to pay for upgrading the existing system and receiving two additional connections, such is certainly very welcomed by the Corporation. If you elect to do so, please do so in writing and be as specific as possible in regards to the general design and cost of the upgraded system, location of such and your contribution for the cost.
