RECITALS

- 1. The Board is authorized under chapter 17, title 42, Idaho Code to operate a water supply bank and to contract with lessors to act as an intermediary in facilitating the rental of water.
- 2. The Lessor has filed a completed application to lease water rights described below into the Water Supply Bank on forms supplied by the Idaho Department of Water Resources and received by the Department on November 19, 2019.
- 3. The Director of the Idaho Department of Water Resources has reviewed the application for compliance with the Water Supply Bank rules and has approved the Lease subject to conditions listed below.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and contracts herein contained, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. WATER RIGHTS: The Lessor shall lease and the Board shall accept into the Bank the Applicant's water rights described as follows:

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- 3. **TERM OF LEASE**: The term of this lease shall be January 1, 2020 to December 31, 2021. This Lease shall bind the parties and take effect when both parties have signed it.
- 4. WATER SUPPLY BANK CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE: The Lessor shall abide by all terms and conditions contained in the Water Supply Bank Conditions of Acceptance, attached hereto as "Attachment A" and incorporated herein by this reference.
- 5. CHANGE OF WATER RIGHT: This lease specifies water right elements including but not limited to: diversion rates; diversion volumes; number of acres authorized to be irrigated; places of use; points of diversion; beneficial uses; and seasons of use. During the term of this lease, if a water right is administratively changed due to a water right split and renumbering, this lease may be reduced by an equal amount to reflect the water right elements as legally defined under the water right. If a lease contract cannot be reduced sufficient to reflect the legal definition of a water right as amended through a water right split and/or water right transfer, the Board may release the water right from the Water Supply Bank.
- 6. ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT: This lease is between the Board and the Lessor, who is the recognized owner or designated representative of the recognized owners of water rights described herein. Should ownership of any part of a water right herein described change during the term of this lease, either through a water right split, a water right transfer, sale of property to which the water right is appurtenant, or through any other recognized water right reassignment, the lease benefits and obligations to the conditions of acceptance for any such water rights will be assigned to the new owners.
- 7. **DUPLICATE ORIGINAL**: This Lease is executed in duplicate. Each of the documents with an original signature of each party shall be an original.

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE

- 1. The water rights referenced above will be rented from the bank at the current rental rate.
- 2. There is no rental payment to the lessor of the water right if the right or a part thereof is not rented from the bank.
- 3. While a right is in the bank, the lessor may not use the right without approval of the Department even if the right is not rented from the bank. Any violation of the terms of this lease may result in enforcement procedures pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-351 for illegal diversion and use of water and may include civil penalties pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701B.
- 4. A right accepted into the bank stays in the bank until the Board releases it, or the lease term expires. A right may be released from the bank upon request, provided the Board approves the release. Unless approved by the Department, leased rights may not be immediately available for release.
- 5. While a water right is in the bank, forfeiture provisions are stayed pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-223(5).
- 6. Rental of water under this right is subject to the limitations and conditions of approval of the water right.
- 7. Failure of the right holder to comply with the conditions of acceptance is cause for the Director to rescind acceptance of the lease.


- Acceptance of a right into the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements
 of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does
 not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other Department
- In accordance with Idaho Code § 42-248 and § 42-1409(6), all owners of water rights are required to notify the Department of any changes in mailing address or change in ownership of all or part of a water right. Notice must be provided within 120 days of the change.
- 10. If a water right leased into the Water Supply Bank is sold or conveyed during the lease term, and if the leased right was rented, the rental proceeds will be disbursed in the following manner regardless of any arrangements between the buyer(s) and seller(s) to the contrary:
 - a. Rental payments will go to the lessor(s) of record at the beginning of the rental season, even if the Department processes a Notice of Change in Water Right Ownership during the rental season.
 - b. New lessor(s) of record will receive payment for any subsequent rental seasons.
- 11. The water right(s) is leased to the bank subject to all prior water rights and shall be administered in accordance with Idaho law and applicable rules of the Department of Water Resources.
- 12. The right holder shall maintain a measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type approved by the Department in a manner that will provide the watermaster suitable control of the diversion.
- 13. Water right 63-33247 when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor exceed a combined annual maximum diversion volume of 35.5 af for irrigation purposes.
- 14. Full beneficial use of all surface water available under water right 63-33244 should occur prior to any use of ground water under 63-33247 and ground water diversions under 63-33247 should be limited to those times when the surface water supply is not available or the surface water supply is not reasonably sufficient for irrigation purposes.
- 15. Rights 63-33244 and 63-33247 when combined are limited to the irrigation of 7.9 acres.
- In recognition of combined limits with water rights 63-32707, 63-32708, 63-32709, 63-32710, 63-32712, 63-32713, 63-32714 and 63-32715, the rental of water rights 63-33244 and 63-33247, when combined, is limited to the irrigation of 7.8 acres
- 17. The unleased extent of water right 63-32707, 63-32708, 63-32709, 63-32710, 63-32712, 63-32713, 63-32714 and 63-32715, when combined, shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 0.73 cfs for the irrigation of 38.5 acres.
- 18. The unleased extent of water rights 63-31738, 63-32404, 63-32405, 63-32407, 63-32408, 63-32637, 63-32638, 63-32707, 63-32708, 63-32709, 63-32710, 63-31740, 63-32413, 63-32414, 63-32416, 63-32417, 63-32639, 63-32640, 63-32712, 63-32713, 63-32714 and 63-32715, and the leased extent of combined, shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 2.40 cfs for the irrigation of 122.3 acres.
- 19. Use of water under this right will be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 63.





Re: Water Supply Bank Lease Proposal

Purpose/Narrative: An application to lease the entire portion of water rights 63-33244 & 63-33247 was received from Mr. Groothuis on November 19, 2019. These rights have been in the Bank previously, leased through 2016 to 2017, then again in 2018 through 2019. A review of the water rights appurtenant to the place of use found that two other rights, 63-32403 & 63-32412, overlap spatially with 63-33244 and 63-33247, however the water right elements are largely additive and they are able to be separated from 63-33244 and 63-33247. Water rights 63-32403 and 63-32412 are also being leased to the Bank at this time, but through application 1505 (contract 1063).

Authority to File: The application was submitted by the current water right owner, Mr. Groothuis with attachment 1A signed by Mrs. Groothuis. The water rights are appurtenant to land owned by the Groothuis Family Revocable Trust. No concerns of authority to file at this time.

Water Right Validity/Forfeiture Evaluation: Review of the water right back file indicates that the rights were decreed in 2009, then leased to the Bank from 2016 to 2017 then again from 2018-2019. Satellite imagery indicates that irrigation has taken place in 2011 and 2015, providing a reasonable defense against forfeiture. No concerns about validity at this time.

Injury Evaluation: No direct injury is apparent however, proper rental review should protect against injury.

Enlargement of Use: No concerns of enlargement through the lease alone as the other rights stacked with these two are able to be separated. Proper rental review should protect against enlargement. Water right 63-33244 was split from parent water right 63-4849, which originally authorized diversion of 2.78 cfs for the irrigation of 139.0 acres. Over time, water right 63-4849 was split into water rights 63-33244, 63-32710, 63-32707, 63-32708, 63-32709, 63-32407, 63-32408, 63-32638, 63-32637, 63-31738, 63-32403, 63-32404, 63-32405 and 63-33243, which combined, collectively authorize a diversion of 2.78 cfs for the irrigation of 139.0 acres.

Water right 63-33243 was specifically split from water right 63-33244 (through Transfer 74412), which resulted in a combined limit for water rights 63-33244, 63-32710, 63-32707, 63-32708 and 63-32709 that included an administrative reduction of 0.1 acres; these six water rights collectively, additively authorize irrigation of 46.5 acres, however they are combined limited to 46.4 acres. To avoid enlargement, the maximum irrigation extent of water right 63-33244 (7.9 acres) will be leased into the Bank, however the rental of the water right will be limited to 7.8 acres.

Local Public Interest: Sustainable management of water throughout Idaho is in the local public interest. As such, comments will be requested from the staff of Water District 63 and IDWR's Western Region office.

Beneficial Use/Conservation of Water Resources: The use of irrigation is consistent with one of the accepted beneficial uses for water throughout the State of Idaho.

Department/Watermaster Comments: Water District 63 and IDWR Western Region comments were requested December 10, 2019.

Water Supply Bank Evaluation: Subject to favorable water district and regional office comments, it is recommended these leases be approved.

I took a look at the 2018 spreadsheet, but based on the sums in that spreadsheet, it wasn't clear to me how we arrived at slightly different numbers in 2018.

In 2018, for the 22 water rights not being leased, we calculated an unleased irrigation extent of 2.44 cfs for 122.2 acres. Yesterday, I calculated an unleased irrigation extent for these same 22 water rights of 2.40 cfs for 122.3 acres. Close, but slightly different.

The following is how I arrived at my sums:

Further, once I calculated the above amounts, I added the base, unleased extent of 2.40 cfs and 122.3 acres to get condition text specific to a contract.

For contract 1048, the unleased extent for the 22 wrs, plus the lease extent of contract 1063 was: (2.40 cfs & 122.3 acres) + (0.13 cfs & 6.2 acres) = 2.53 cfs for 128.5 acres;

While for contract 1063, the unleased extent for 22 wrs, plus the lease extent for contract 1048 was: (2.40 cfs & 122.3 acres) + (0.19 cfs & 7.8 acres) = 2.59 cfs for 130.1 acres;

I wrote the conditions in this way so that, if one contract was terminated earlier than the other, the remaining balance wouldn't change (e.g. the unleased extent would increase by the amount per the cancelled contract, which is the same amount calculated).

I'm not sure if there is a standard procedure for how to write out the remaining balance of water use for combined limited water rights that are not part of a specific lease contract, is there?
