ORDER AUTHORIZING  
TEMPORARY CHANGE TC-34-31

WHEREAS, a drought emergency has been declared for CUSTER  
County to allow administrative actions to lessen the severe impacts of the drought  
conditions in the counties; and

WHEREAS, section 42-222A, Idaho Code, provides that upon declaration of a  
drought emergency, the director of the Department of Water Resources ("Department")  
is authorized to allow temporary changes in the point of diversion, the place of use, and  
the purpose of use for valid existing water rights when the director determines that such  
changes can be accomplished in accordance with the provisions of section 42-222A,  
Idaho Code; and

WHEREAS, on 6/27/03, Wildhorse Partners LLC submitted the attached  
Temporary Change Application TC-34-31 to the Department; and

WHEREAS, the Department has reviewed the application and has determined  
the application can be approved with certain conditions;

## ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application is APPROVED subject to the  
following conditions:

1. Diversion and use of right no(s). 34-703C is authorized only  
at the point of diversion and place of use described on the application.
2. This temporary change approval does not authorize construction of a new  
well as a new point of diversion.
3. The applicant assumes all risk of curtailment or mitigation should the  
diversion and use of water under the temporary change approval cause  
injury to other water rights, constitute an enlargement in use of the original  
right, be inconsistent with the conservation of water resources within the  
state of Idaho, or not be in the local public interest.
4. This temporary change approval may only be used to provide a

replacement water supply to lands or other uses which normally have a full water supply, except for the drought condition. This temporary change approval may not be used to provide water for new development or to allow expansion of the use of water under existing water rights.

5. Right(s) 34-703C are limited to the irrigation of a total of 38.5 acres in a single irrigation season.
6. This temporary approval does not authorize the use of diversion works or a delivery system owned by or managed by a corporation or an irrigation district without the written consent of such corporation or irrigation district.
7. The applicant agrees to hold the director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of the diversion and use of water under this temporary change approval.
8. This temporary change approval does not grant any right-of-way or easement to use the diversion works or conveyance works of another person or entity.
9. The applicant shall measure the amount of water diverted and shall report the amount of water diverted under this approval.
10. The watermaster of Water District No. 34 is authorized to administer the temporary change approval.
11. This temporary change approval expires on Oct 31, 2003 unless rescinded or extended by the director. Thereafter, the water right shall revert to the point of diversion, place of use and nature of use existing prior to the temporary change approval.

Remarks:

1. General  
Use of water under this right is subject to the terms of the mitigation plan submitted by the right holder. Rights 34-00703B, 34-00704B, 34-00573B, 34-00583B, 34-00584D, 34-00699B, 34-00702B, and portions of Rights 34-00703C, 34-00704C, 34-00699C, 34-00700C, 34-00701C and 34-00702C are to serve as mitigation for diversion under this right for any irrigation season that the right holder wishes to divert groundwater instead of surface water.  
The water normally delivered under Rights 34-00703B, 34-00704B, 34-00573B, 34-00583B, 34-00584D, 34-00699B, 34-00702B and portions of Rights 34-0070C, 34-00704C, 34-00699C, 34-00700C, 34-00701C and 34-00702C shall remain undiverted in Warm Springs Creek and the Big Lost River in any year that the right holder diverts groundwater under this right.  
Water rights from the Warm Springs Creek source shall be subject to terms and limitations contained in the Stipulation, Settlement, and Joint Motion for Order filed with the Department on October 12, 1999, in the matter of Application for Permit No. 34-07591, in the name of L & S Partners, numerous other captioned matters, and the Preliminary Order of the Department issued on November 18, 1999.  
This approval is subject to any future modifications resulting from or required by the terms of that Stipulation, the Preliminary Order of the Department, and the actions taken pursuant thereto.  
Water will not be diverted from groundwater under this right at such times when an equivalent amount of the surface water rights provided for mitigation is not deliverable.  
The right holder shall be entitled to cease use of the groundwater right and resume use of the surface water rights upon request in writing to the Water District 34 watermaster prior to the beginning of the irrigation season. The right holder shall not be entitled to divert from both sources in any year.  
Prior to diversion of water under this right, the right holder shall install and maintain a measuring device and a totalizing meter which displays the instantaneous rate of diversion from the well. Written notice of compliance with this condition shall be submitted to IDWR. If the measuring device or totalizing meter becomes inoperable at any time, diversion of water from the well under this right shall cease.  
Rights 34-00573B, 34-00583B, 34-00584D, 34-00699C, 34-00700C, 34-00701C, 34-00702B, 34-00702C, 34-00703B, 34-00703C, 34-00704B, 34-00704C, and 34-07595 when combined shall not exceed the irrigation of 269.2 total acres.  
During any irrigation season that groundwater is diverted under this right, use of water rights 34-00573B, 34-00583B, 34-00584D, 34-00699C, 34-00700C, 34-00701C, 34-00702B, 34-00702C, 34-00703B, 34-00703C, 34-00704B and 34-00704C is limited to a total combined diversion rate of 4.70 cfs.
