This letter is in protest of application #78-12515, filed by Jeffrey J. Clemmer.

Mr. Clemmer has applied for the right to divert 37 miners inches from Goose Creek. The issue with this is that he is proposing to divert this water into the delivery system known as the Goose Creek Canal. The Goose Creek Canal Company currently runs at full water capacity and delivers water to its shareholders. Jeffrey Clemmer is not a shareholder.

After visiting with Mr. Clemmer, I believe his true intention is to capture and use the overflow water from the Canyon Creek Subdivision's fire suppression pond. I would encourage him to try to reach some type of arrangement with the Canyon Creek Property Owners Association. Any workable deal with Canyon Creek should be of greater value than a junior water right in Goose Creek, that has no available delivery system.
