ACTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

The Idaho Department of Water Resources hereby approves the above Application for Amendment for Permit No. 15-7121 with the following:

Conditions of Approval

1. Rights 15-7117 and 15-7121 when combined shall not exceed the irrigation of 159.8 acres.
2. After specific notification by the Department, the right holder shall install a suitable measuring device or shall enter into an agreement with the Department to use power records to determine the amount of water diverted and shall annually report the information to the Department.
3. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 3.5 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the place of use.

This amendment is issued pursuant to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-211.
