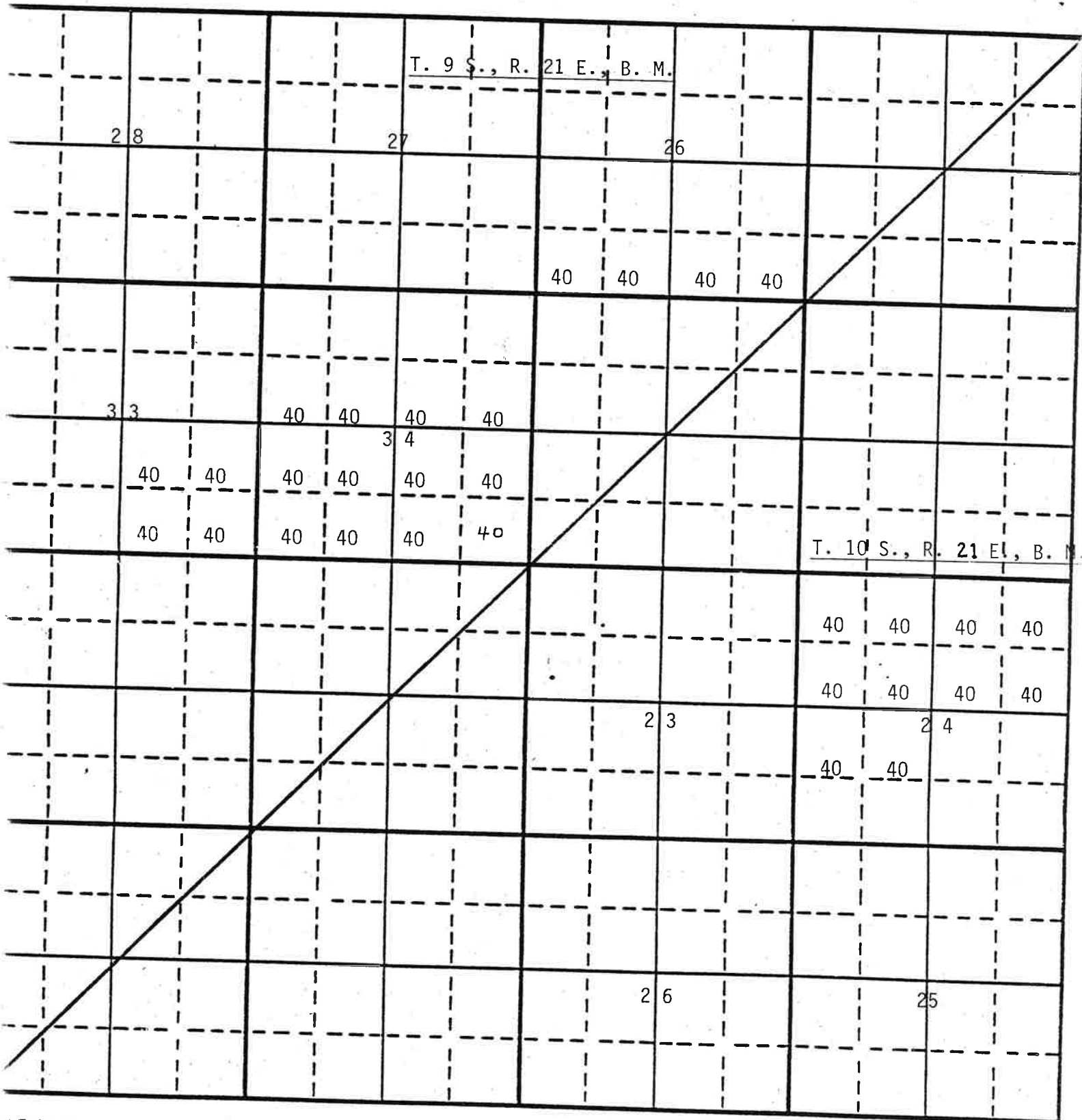

This application is to change the place of use of Palisades Reservoir storage water from lands described in License No. R 670/01-2068 but which are not receiving service from said facility, to lands proposed to receive water service through the Unit A Extension of the North Side Pumping Division of the Minidoka Federal Reclamation Project. This storage right is intended to be supplemental to a direct flow right on the newly replaced 1,200 acres.
