6. Basis of protest (including statement of facts and law upon which the protest is based).

Protestant has information that indicates in excess of 115 cfs of additional groundwater development is proposed in the vicinity of its Lake Lowell reservoir, and that the cumulative effects of that proposed development has not been modeled or even adequately described. See Exhibit 1. Protestant is concerned about the cumulative effects that groundwater withdrawals in the Lake Lowell vicinity may have adversely affecting its senior water rights in Lake Lowell, and therefore submits this Protest. Additionally, the Boise Project believes that the additional development will adversely affect in water supply in canal and drains that service Lake Lowell, and irrigation district patrons.

7. What would resolve your protest?
Assurances by the Applicant and IDWR that levels of Lake Lowell and water supplies in its canals and drains will not be adversely affected by the diversion proposed by Application 63-34616, either individually, or cumulatively with water right claim nos. 63-33644, 63-33625, 63-33629, 63-33713, 63-33763, 63-33777, 63-33756, 63-33131, 63-33132, 63-33133, 63-33134, 63-33135, 63-33639, 63-33811, 63-33814, 63-33900, 63-33901, 63-

33810, 63-33894, 63-34087, 63-34050, 63-34045, 63-34157, 63-34320, 63-34541, and 63-34542.

I hereby acknowledge that if I, or my designated representative, fails to appear at any regularly scheduled conference or hearing in the matter of which I have been notified at the address above, the department may issue a notice of proposed default against me in this matter for failure to appear. I also verify that I have served a copy of this protest upon the applicant.

Re: Applications for Permits, Ground Water in South Canyon County

Dear Interested Party:

A number of applications seeking new appropriations of ground water generally south of Lake Lowell have been filed by various parties. To date, the total amount of ground water sought is about 115 cubic feet per second (cfs). The total extent of proposed development remains unclear – estimated annual volume to divert etc. The Idaho Department of Water Resources (IDWR) asked the applicants for additional information regarding water supply, injury to senior water rights, local public interest and so forth. Some applicants provided more information while other responses are pending.

Please refer to the enclosed list of applications. They can be grouped in priority order as follows.

- Farm Development et al senior applications 63-33131 through 63-33135 propose most of the additional water for the area. The proposed use will be supplemental irrigation. IDWR does not know the anticipated extent of supplemental irrigation on an annual basis for these applications (expected rate and volume of ground water needed).
- WDT Lake View application 63-33625 includes a relatively modest rate and volume for irrigation. This application might not be significantly related to the others due to its proximity to Lake Lowell.
- Beranna Dairy application 63-33629 includes a significant rate of flow and proposes to bring land irrigated under other rights up to a full 0.02 cfs/acre with little if any additional volume expected to be diverted.
- Snake River Dairies application 63-33639 covers land in the southwest corner of Ada County. It is included due to its similar scope and location compared to the other filings. This application includes supplemental and primary irrigation.
- SunRidge Dairy applications 63-33644 and 63-33713 include a significant rate of flow. They propose to bring land irrigated under other rights up to a full 0.02 cfs/acre with little if any additional volume expected to be diverted.

IDWR has been asked to identify information the department has regarding ground water in the general area south of Lake Lowell. The following summary is provided for your consideration whether you are preparing additional information to support your application(s) or have already responded to IDWR in that regard.
