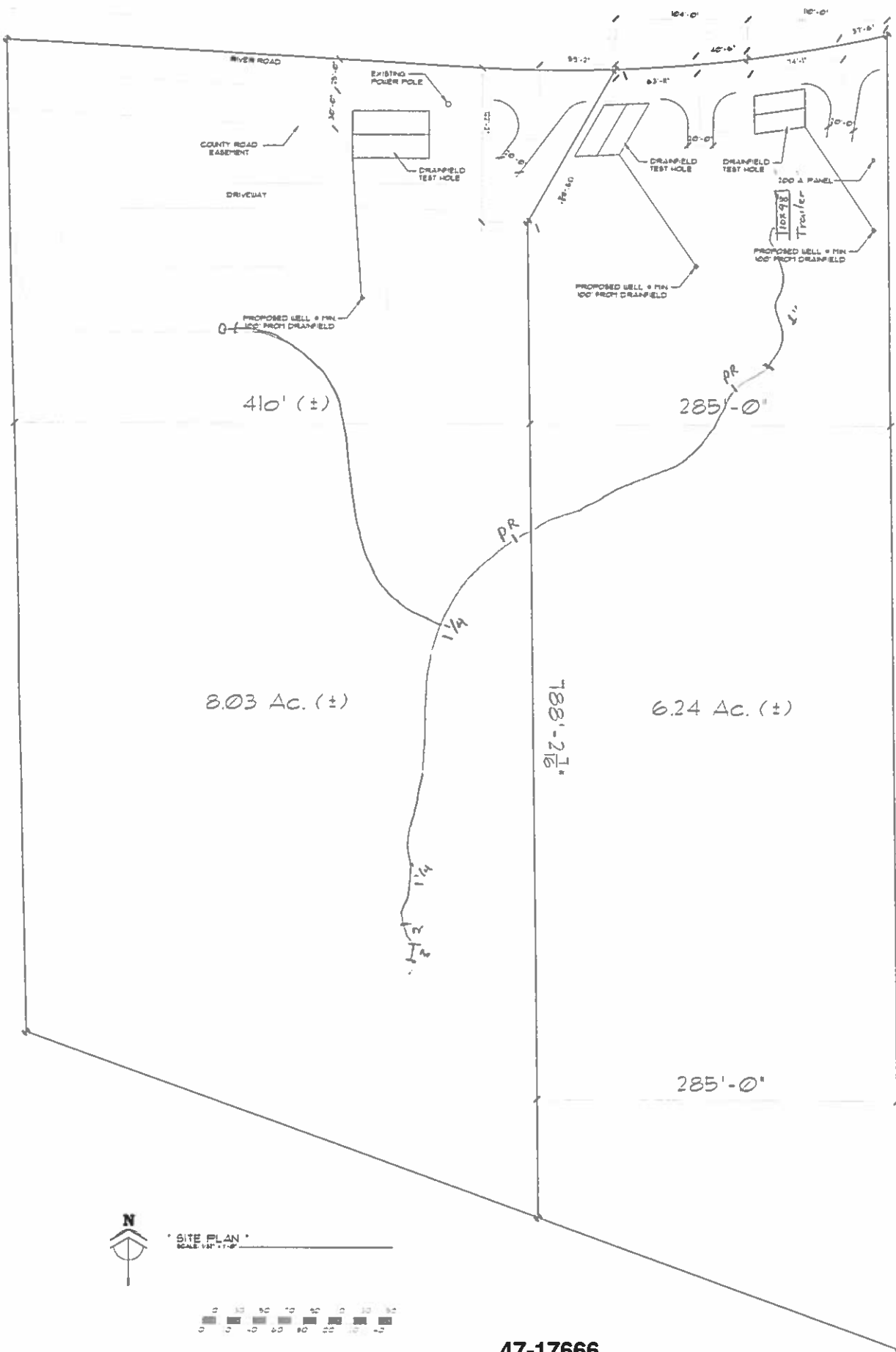

Dear Mr. Beaudet:

This letter is to inform you that the Twin Falls County Planning and Zoning Administration hereby approves your request for the Administrative Land Division on property consisting of approximately fourteen point three one (14.31) ± acres in Section 09, Township 09 South, Range 15 East, B.M. Twin Falls, Idaho in the Rural Residential Zone. This letter serves as your authorization to proceed with the division to create a parcel of land consisting of approximately six point two four (6.24) ± acres with the following conditions: address the concerns of the various commenting agencies. Any further divisions on the property will require a subdivision plat process.

Please be advised that property may be subject to potential rock falls and that run off channels were also observed that may affect the location of the homes or require other mitigation methods. This will need to be addressed upon application for a building permit.

Please be further advised that Twin Falls County Code only allows for one (1) home per parcel.

Per Twin Falls County Code Title 8...

SECTION 8-6D-2: PRINCIPAL DESIGNATED USES in the Rural Residential Zone -- Single-family dwelling units.

SECTION 8-9-10: PERMITTED LAND SPLITS -- The following conditions must be met:

- A. One acre minimum or as required per South Central Health District.
- B. All necessary utility, road and irrigation easements providing access for services to the parcels must be provided.
- C. Private roads provided by the owner must have a road maintenance agreement, which runs with the land.

- D. If water shares are available to the land then the owner must provide a written water use and maintenance agreement, which shall run with the land and conform to the requirements of the respective canal company or district.
- E. A copy of the deed must be submitted to the Planning and Zoning Department showing the above easements along with copies of any of the above agreements.

You will need to contact a surveyor to acquire a legal description and survey. The legal and survey must be recorded, along with the nuisance waiver, at the recorders office, which is located on the second floor of the Twin Falls County West Building. Please note that the division and nuisance waiver must be recorded with the County Recorder and Assessor within one year from the above date. Violation of this regulation renders the approval null and void. Recording of this letter will not fulfill this requirement.

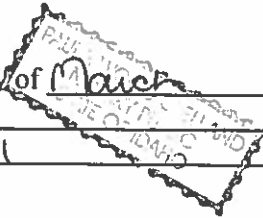
Also, permits are required for any building to be constructed or placed on the property, and the permit may be obtained through this office providing all agencies requirements are met. General setbacks are in accordance with Section 8-6D-5. D. please contact this office for more specific information regarding any setback questions. Permissible Place of Use (PPU) for thirty-six ground water rights which currently irrigate 3000.7 acres on ground located approximately 9.5 to 15.5 miles north and 1.7 miles west to 1.9 miles east of Malta. The rights are currently irrigating ground under three separate entities and this transfer will consolidate the rights into a single PPU in the same general area. One group of 3 rights irrigates 60.5 acres with a 1.17 cfs flow rate, another group of 3 rights irrigates 346.0 acres with a 6.22 cfs flow rate, and the final group of 30 rights irrigates 2594.2 acres with a total flow rate of 39.78 cfs. After the transfer, 3000.7 acres will be irrigated with a combined flow rate of 47.17 cfs within the proposed 4038.2 acre PPU.
