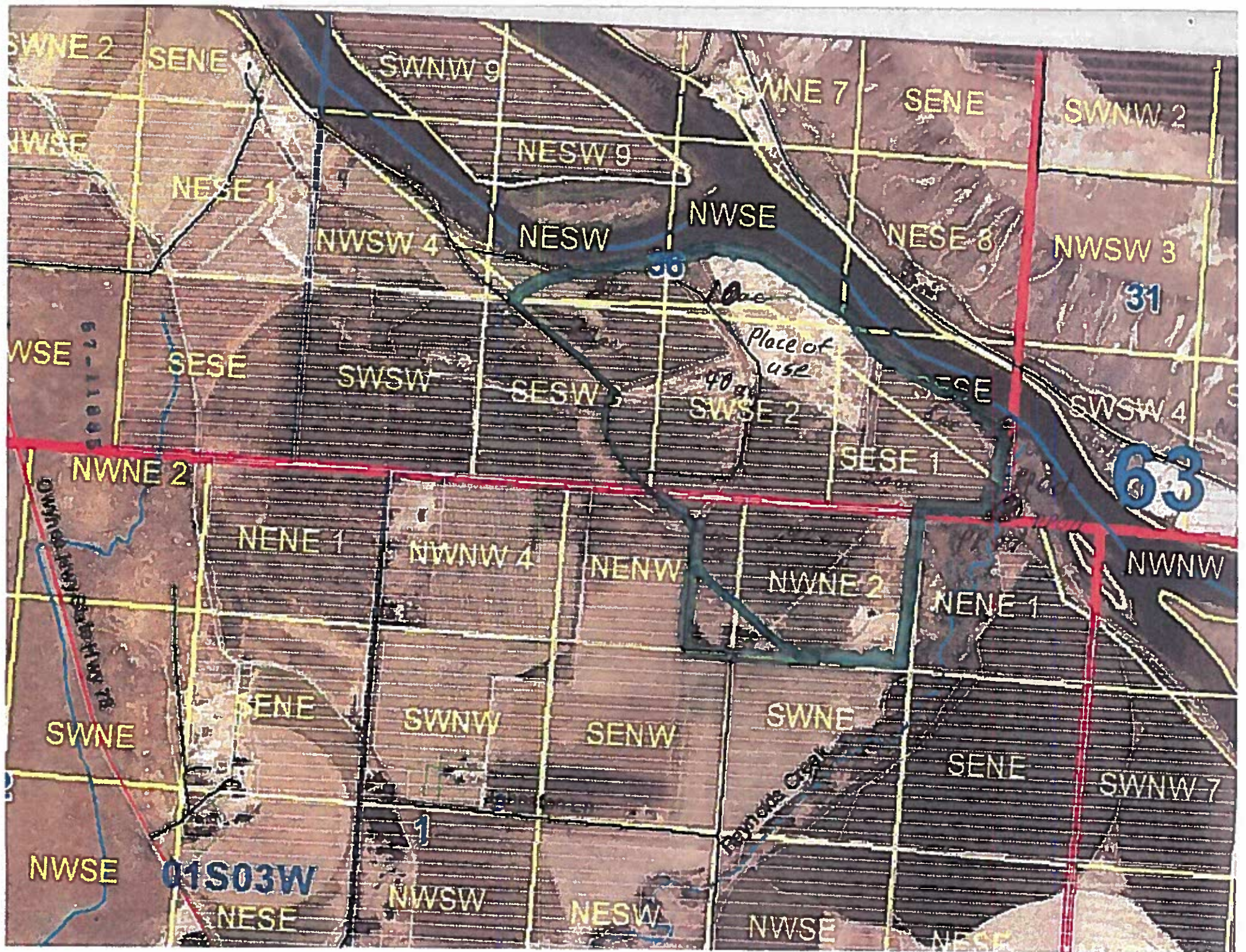

To Whom It May Concern:

We propose to use a portion of the wastewater that is in Reynolds Creek for irrigating purposes. The point of diversion will be approximately 300 yards from the mouth of the creek. The diversion will consist of cement blocks, gravel (already there), and boards. A short canal (150-200 Ft) will be dug to insure safety from flooding, at the end of which will be a settling pond and re-pump station. All work will be done on ground owned by Hook Land Company. The wastewater will be used on preexisting farm ground as a supplement for preexisting water rights (2-206, 2-2086, 57-276).

The water that is in the creek at the POD is wastewater from fields east of Hwy 78 and adjacent to the creek. All of the water comes into the creek system after it crosses under Hwy 78 and after all the current PODs. This water has a very high level of sediment and we assume, a higher temperature due to having been spread over the fields. We would like to use this water in an effort to "clean" it up. Our fields are largely grass and alfalfa fields, so the wastewater, if there is any, is much cleaner than that which comes off the row crop fields. Our soil is not deep, just a few inches of sandy loam, with sand and gravel below that. The result is that it takes a very large amount of water to cover the ground. Rarely, if ever, do we have "run-off". The water just simply goes away and reenters the river system via springs all along our river front property.

In reality we are filing this right because we need the water to grow the pasture and hay that we like to have in the ground adjacent to the river. It is better for us and, we feel, for the river to have long term stands of pasture and hay in this ground. Right now, due to lack of water, we are fall planting small grains for fall and spring pasture. Of course this means we have to farm the ground and bare it off, so there is some sedimentation that does get to the river, very little, but some. With this additional water right we will have enough water in July and August to be able to put in permanent pasture or long-term hay stands.

Another reason for filing this right is a marked change in the farming practices adjacent to our property. In the last ten years there has been about 300 acres of farm ground put under pressurized systems (120 acres under our own pivot). All of this ground is "up stream" from us. As a result, we do not get the wastewater that we relied on in the past. Additionally, whereas in the past our farm ground was sub-irrigated, it is now drying up and the water table is dropping. This additional water right will help us get back to where we have been in the past.

We understand that water is valuable and precious resource that must be used carefully. It is our thought that this right will allow us to put this wastewater to good use with more than a little benefit to the river system in the form of cleaner water.
