MEMORANDUM

Re: Bs 63 Moratorium Evaluation

This application proposes to divert spring water tributary to sinks for irrigation of 0.5 acres in the Boise River Basin, upstream of the Star Bridge. Application Processing Memo #59 forbids the further appropriation of surface water and shallow groundwater (<200 ft.) in this area. However, Memo 59 also outlines the director's ability to evaluate such applications on a case-by-case basis if the "public interest, as determined by the Director, requires immediate consideration of approval of the application." The Ada County Highway Department (ACHD) has submitted a letter concerning this application which provides proof that the proposed diversion is related to the "protection and furtherance of public interest" (Amended Moratorium Order, 1993), by stating that the diversion will "benefit the District and the taxpayers by reducing impacts to public infrastructure."

Furthermore, Application Processing Memo #59 allows applications for shallow groundwater to be processed if "the application seeks the appropriation of ground water for domestic purposes as such term is defined in Idaho Code 42-111." The spring to be diverted, according to this application, is a tributary to "sinks" which recharges the shallow groundwater. Therefore, this application should be treated as a shallow groundwater diversion. The proposed use, to irrigate 0.5 acres, falls within the definition of "domestic" according to Idaho Code 42-111, so this application is available for processing.
