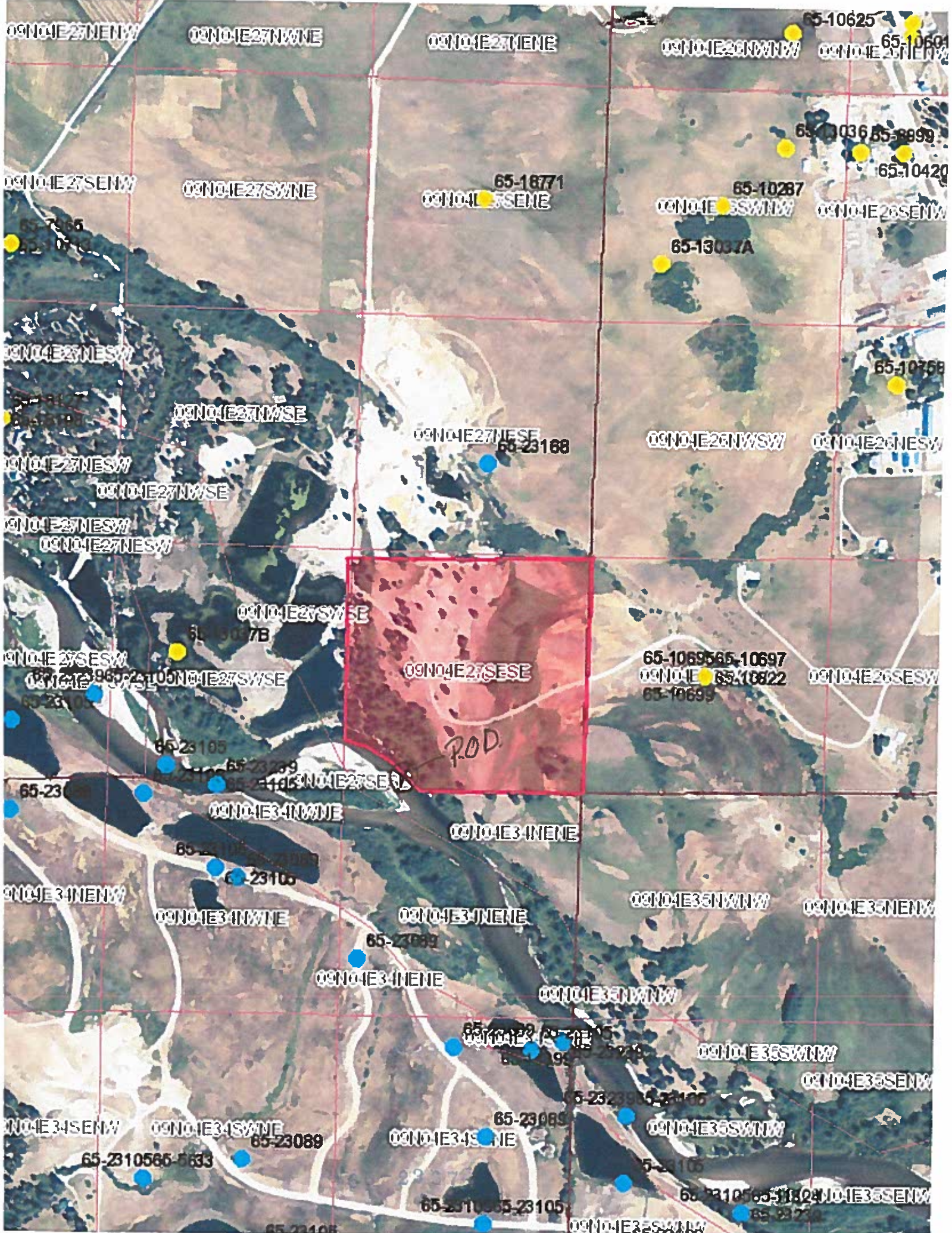

The previous owner also maintained the land in the agricultural category I presumed through leased grazing permits for cattle and or sheep as it appears the property has remained in natural meadow grasslands.

Since I don't expect to purchase a herd of cattle or sheep it is my intent to make an income from raising crops. To do so I have filed a request for a water right with a point of diversion from the south fork of the Payette River running adjacent to the property.

We have filed an application for Water Rights as of August 30th of this year, 2016

I'm requesting an expedition of the water rights application in order to begin to set up the land and required systems to irrigate as quickly as possible.

Since the title of the land changed the County Assessor has formally notified me that I will need to prove that I have kept the land in an 'Agricultural Category' or forfeit the land status for an Agricultural exemption for tax reasons.


This loss would create an undue burden on my costs in starting up this farming operation.
