CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. Proof of application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before **July 01, 2021**.
2. Subject to all prior water rights.
3. This right is limited to the irrigation of 215.4 acres within the authorized place of use in a single irrigation season.
4. Use of water under this right will be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 11.
5. Prior to diversion of water under this right, the right holder shall install and maintain a measuring device and lockable controlling works of a type acceptable to the Department as part of the diverting works.
6. The place of use described in this right is located in Utah. Water is delivered through Cub River Canal.

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7. This right is intended to mirror Utah water rights 25-3263 and 25-3265 and represents the same use of water described under those rights. This right and Utah water rights 25-3263 and 25-3265 when combined shall not exceed a total diversion rate of 5.10 cfs, a total annual maximum diversion volume of 358.2 acre-feet, or the irrigation of 215.4 acres.

This permit is issued pursuant to the provisions of Section 42-204, Idaho Code. Witness the signature affixed below, this 17th day of June, 2016.
