ORDER RESCHEDULING HEARING

On September 4, 2015, the Department agreed to hold a hearing on John Kugler's ("Kugler") application for drilling permit initially denied on November 26, 2014. The Department scheduled the hearing for 9:00 a.m. on December 10, 2015. Kugler asked the Department to reschedule the start time for the hearing to accommodate his need to travel from the State of Washington on the morning of the hearing.

ORDER

The Department will hold a hearing to receive Kugler's evidence and testimony in connection with the application for drilling permit only. The hearing scheduled for 9:00 a.m. on December 10, 2015, is **RESCHEDULED** to 10:30 a.m. on December 10, 2015.

In addition to any other evidence or testimony Kugler may present at the hearing, Kugler shall provide exhibits containing the following information needed to complete the application for drilling permit:

- The proposed location of the well, to the quarter-quarter section of the public land survey system.
- The proposed casing diameter for the well.
- The proposed maximum depth of the well.
- The name of the drilling company that will construct the well.
- The anticipated bottom hole water temperature from among the following three categories:
 - 85° F or less
 - 85° F to 212° F
 - 212° F or more

NOTICE OF HEARING

The Department hereby provides notice that a hearing on Kugler's petition is set for **December 10, 2015, beginning at 10:30 a.m.**, at the Department's State Office, located at 322 E. Front Street, 6th Floor Conference Rooms, Boise, Idaho. The presiding officer at the hearing will be Shelley Keen.


Rule 606 of the Department's Rules of Procedure requires that copies of exhibits intended for use at the hearing be provided to each party and to the presiding officer, whose mailing address is P.O. Box 83720, Boise, Idaho 83720-0098.

The hearing will be held in accordance with provisions of Chapters 2 and 17, Title 42 and Chapter 52, Title 67, *Idaho Code*, and the adopted Rules of Procedure of the Department, IDAPA 37.01.01. A copy of the Rules of Procedure may be obtained from the Department upon request.

The hearing will be conducted in a facility which meets the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you require special accommodations in order to attend, participate in or understand the conference, please contact Jean Hersley at (208) 287-4942, no later than five (5) days prior to the hearing.

During the course of the hearing, Kugler will have the opportunity to present information, examine witnesses, and provide argument on issues related to Kugler's petition.
