CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL RENTED WATER RIGHTS

1. The use of water under this agreement shall be subject to the provisions of Idaho Code § 42-1766.
2. Rental of the specified right from the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
3. Use of water under this agreement does not constitute a dedication of the water to renter's place of use, and upon expiration of this agreement, the points of diversion and place of use of the water shall revert to those authorized under the water right and/or again be available to rent from the bank.
4. This rental does not grant any right-of-way or easement to use the diversion works or conveyance works of another party.
5. Use of water under this agreement shall not prejudice any action of the Department in its consideration of an application for transfer or permit filed by the applicant for this same use.
6. Renter agrees to comply with all applicable state and federal laws while using water under this agreement.
7. Renter agrees to hold the Board, the Director and the state of Idaho harmless from all liability on account of negligent acts of the renter while using water.
8. Renter acknowledges and agrees that the Director may terminate diversion of water if the Director determines there is not a sufficient water supply for the priority of the right or portion thereof being rented.
9. Failure of the renter to comply with the conditions of this agreement is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the rental agreement.
10. After specific notification by the Department, the right holder shall install a suitable measuring device or shall enter into an agreement with the Department to determine the amount of water diverted from power records and shall annually report the information to the Department.

11. This rental agreement does not authorize the construction of a well.
12. This right when combined with all other rights shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 4.5 afa per acre at the field headgate for irrigation of the lands above.
13. The following rights are diverted through point(s) of diversion described above: 63-10785, 63-31505 and 63-31178.
14. The use of water for irrigation under rights 63-33313 and 63-33314 may continue to as late as November 15, provided other elements of the right are not exceeded. The use of water after October 15 under this remark is subordinate to all water rights having no subordinated early or late irrigation use and a priority date earlier than the date a partial decree is entered for this right.

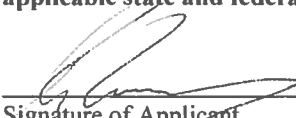

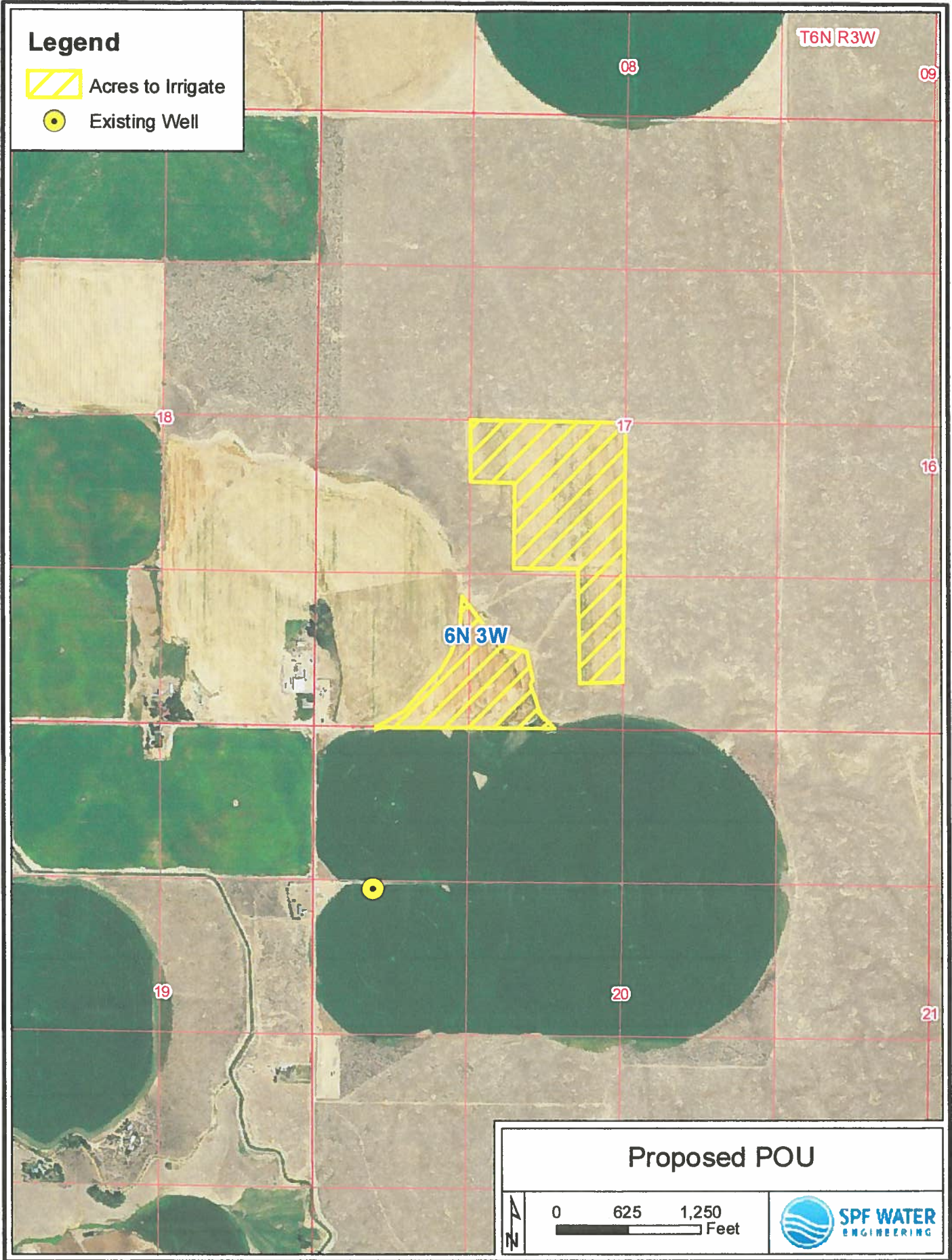

Lease shall be for the year 2014-2015 for the purpose of growing crops. Lessee shall provide records to the lessor all the herbicides and pesticides used on the farm at the end of the farm lease. Lessors shall be responsible for carrying insurance on irrigation system. Lessee shall be responsible for paying the Idaho Power bill for irrigation power bills. Lessor shall be responsible for paying the water bill for 68 acre Black Canyon Irrigation District (BCID), water right and property taxes.

Cash rent shall be paid as follows: Cash lease shall be \$15,350.00 total for the land described in the legal. \$7675.00 *due and payable on the 1ST of June, 2015 and the balance of \$7675.00 due and payable on the 1st of Dec, 2015. *Note lessee shall pay the spring 2015 water Bill from BCID Spring 2015 Assessment Bill in the amount of (\$ verify) for the 68 acre BCID water right, and deduct it from the total lease amount due on June 1st.

That lessee hereby gives to the lessor a lien upon all crops grown on the said land under this lease, to secure the payment of the rental hereinbefore reserved, including damages for breach of covenants herein contained.

1. - To farm the said premises and the whole thereof (except as herein provided otherwise), throughout the said term and care for the crops grown after the manner of good husbandry.
2. - To keep ditch banks, fence rows and road sides free from weeds.
3. - Not to assign this lease or sublet any portion of said premises without the written consent thereto of the lessors.
4. - To permit the lessors, their agent or agents to enter into and upon said premises and each and every portion thereof at any time or times, for inspection thereof and of the crops thereon.
5. - To permit the lessors, his agent or agents to enter into and upon the said premises in the fall of the year to do fall plowing, plant crops for the coming year and to do any and all work that may be necessary to do upon any or all of the said premises.
6. - To quit and surrender possession of the said premises on the expiration of said term.
7. - To commence plowing said ground as soon as the weather will permit and as speedily as possible prepare ground for planting.
8. - That the lessee shall have the use of the water for the purpose of watering said premises, under the 68 acre BCID water right appurtenant thereto. Lessee will be responsible for the maintenance of the irrigation system including pumps, pivots, handlines, and underground water supply lines for the water

delivery on said prem

9. That the water rent or maintenance shall be paid for the term by the Lessor for the water bill for 68 acre BCID water right. Any fines for overages or associated costs for the mis- use or miss appropriation of any water right or transfer of water right associated with this property will be the sole responsibility of the lessee.
10. That the lessee shall not have any claim against the lessors for damages by reason of any shortage of water, not caused by the lessors neglect.
11. Hunting Rights: All hunting rights on the lands herein leased are reserved to Lessor and shall not permit any hunting except to Tom Delorenzo and Rex Harvey.
12. All labor performed and materials supplied by tenant on the said premises for any purpose during the term of this lease shall conclusively be deemed to have been done and furnished on behalf of and at the sole expense of Lessee, unless the parties hereto have agreed in writing in respect to particular items of such labor and materials in advance of the performance or furnishing of the same that the same are to be deemed extra work and materials outside the scope of this lease, for which compensation is to be made by lessor to lessee, and unless the amount or rate of such compensation is fixed by the terms of said writing; and the lessee shall not be entitled to claim compensation therefore unless lessor has so ordered the same and agreed to pay therefore as herein provided
13. Lessee shall replace the fence on the SW and SE property line if lessor requests. Lessee will replace at his cost the same as the original type he removed at both locations, which is metal post and barbed wire.
14. Lessee shall keep and save harmless the said premises and the crops grown thereon, and lessor herein , from any liens against the same on account of bills, debts for labor or materials incurred by lessee.
15. In the event the lessee or lessee shall take any legal action to enforce or interpret any of the terms of this contract , the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover from the other party all expenses while it may reasonably occur whether incurred in a suit or action or appeal from a judgement in connection w/ legal action.
16. Lessor agrees as long as lessee performs requirements of these covenants lessee shall have and enjoy quiet and peaceful possession of said premises for entire term of the lease term.
17. Lessee will remove all farm equipment from east side of driveway with- in 2 weeks of request by lessor.
18. This lease is for the 2015 growing season only and the 2015 growing season lease will be reviewed after June 2015 by tenant for 2016 growing season.

That in case of any breach of covenant or covenants herein contained to be kept and performed by the lessee or any cause of removal or disposition of any portion of said crops without the consent of the lessors, the lessors agent or agents shall have the right to enter into and upon said premises and eject all persons therefrom, to take possession thereof and of the crops thereon, and give such crops care and attention and protection as they may require. That the lessee agrees on demand in writing therefore, to pay lessors the expense incurred by the lessors in and about caring for and attending to said crops.

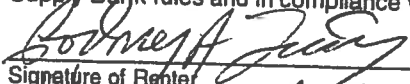
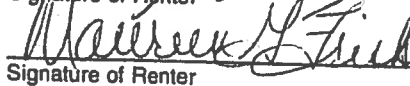
