✓ **PROPOSED CHANGE OF WATER RIGHTS**

Warm Springs Ditch Co. of 1840 N. Lakes Ave., Meridian, ID, 83646, filed Application No. 79654 to transfer three water rights with 1876 to 1889 priority dates from the Boise River totaling 7.76 cfs. The purpose of the transfer is to change the nature of use for 3.5 acres, 0.07 cfs and 10.2 af to aesthetic storage and diversion to storage uses. The proposed change will mitigate for evaporative losses from the ponds in Banbury Meadows. An application for permit 63-34002 was filed for the Banbury pond system. Water will be used in the Warm Springs Ditch Co. service area in the Banbury Meadows subdivision located south of W. Colchester Drive, west of N. Locust Grove Road and east of S. Eagle Road.

Permits will be subject to all prior water rights. The protestant must also send a copy of the protest to the applicant.
