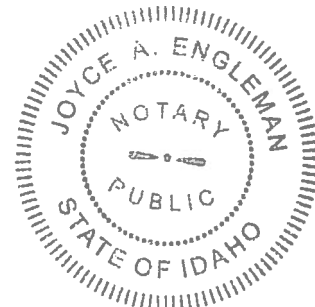

The purpose of the transfer is to change a portion of the above rights as follows: This application intends to change the place of use, period of use, point of diversion, and nature of use for a 0.06 cfs portion of water right 36-8478. The right is currently used for year round stockwater and commercial use at a dairy, located approximately 3.0 to 3.5 miles south and 2.5 to 3.0 miles west of the center of Jerome. The application proposes changing the use to irrigation (period of use from 3/15 to 11/15) with a proposed place of use and new point of diversion (an existing well) located approximately 4.0 miles south and 1.3 miles west of the center of Jerome.

The purpose of the transfer is to change a portion of the above rights as follows: Application proposes adding two new points of diversion to three groundwater rights used to irrigate up to 770.8 acres on the main Six S Ranch property located east of Declo. The new points of diversion will consist of two new wells to be drilled with both of the wells being located approximately 5.1 miles east of the 100 South and Highway 77 intersection in Declo. The application indicates that no more than 2.23 cfs will be diverted from the two new wells.

SUN VALLEY CO, A WYOMING CORP, PO BOX 10, SUN VALLEY, ID 83353, has filed Application No. 79190 for changes to the following water rights within BLAINE County(s): Right No (s) 37-415, 37-416. The purpose of the transfer is to change a portion of the above rights as follows: Transfer proposes to change the place of use for irrigation use of water rights 37-415 and 37-416 from subdivided and developed lands of the original farm and resort to new irrigation of recent golf course development on the ridge west of Trail Creek. The rights were decreed for 22.2 cfs and 516.3 acres of irrigation along with 9.3 cfs of water for aesthetic and wildlife use within a 628.6 acre area that included Sun Valley Resort lands and some or all of approximately 17 subdivisions, including but not limited to the various Fairway, Prospector, Trail Creek, East Lake Subdivisions and New Villager, Dollar Meadows and Cottonwood Condominiums. The proposed 516.3 acre irrigation place of use are part of Sun Valley Resort, northeast of Ketchum along Trail Creek, but also include some of the above subdivisions and additional other lots, condominium areas and subdivisions.
