Dear Water Right Holder(s):

The Department acknowledges the receipt of correspondence changing ownership of the above referenced water right(s) to you. The Department has modified its records to reflect this change in ownership and has enclosed a computer-generated report for your records. The Department made this change based on the warranty deed that you provided. The deed listed the water right number incorrectly but conveyed Lot 3, of Adams Gulch Subdivision in Blaine County, which is what the Department based the ownership change on.


Updating the ownership record for a water right does not reconfirm the validity of the right. When processing an ownership change notice, the department does not review the history of water use to determine if the right has been forfeited through five years or more of non-use. To read more about water right forfeiture, including how to protect a water right from forfeiture, please see Sections 42-222 and 42-223, Idaho Code.

Please note that as of July 1, 1996, water right owners are required to report any change of water right ownership and any change of mailing address of the owner of a water right, to the Department. Notice of the change must be provided to the Department within 120 days of the change. Change reporting forms are available from any office of the Department, or at www.idwr.idaho.gov.

Also note, water right 37-2165D was leased to the Water Supply Bank on (Bank) on April 6, 2013. In accordance with the Bank lease acceptance, the lessor/current right holder (right holder) may not use the right(s) while it is in theBank, even if the right(s) is not rented from the Bank. The right(s) will remain in the Bank until December 31, 2015, unless released earlier by the Water Resource Board or upon request by the right holder. To reduce the term of the lease, the right holder must submit a written request to the department. The department will verify if the right is rented or available for release, and notify the right holder of the release date.
