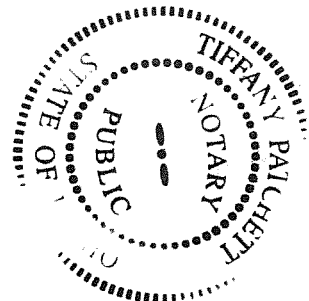

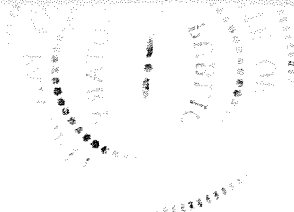

Jonathon &/or Gretchen Moldenhauer of 14716 Mountain Hawk Rd., Nampa, ID, 83686, filed Application No. 78956 to transfer a portion of one water right with a 1967 priority date from a ground water source totaling 0.041 cfs. The purpose of the transfer is to split the water right and add an existing well for the property that has been separated. ✓ **PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF WATER PERMIT**

J. C. Watson Company Inc. of PO Box 300, Parma, ID, 83660, filed Application No. 79164 to amend a water permit with a 2009 priority from ground water totaling 2.74 cfs for irrigation purposes.
