NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGE TO WATER RIGHTS

Notice is hereby given that an Application for Transfer has been filed with the Idaho Department of Water Resources for changes to water rights within Blaine County: **EASTFIELD AT BELLEVUE FARMS HOA**, PO BOX 301; BELLEVUE ID 83313 filed **Application No. 70929** on 12/9/03 and AMENDED on 2/26/2004. This application proposes to change the point of diversion for the portion of this license owned by the applicant. The existing well is located where the District Canal delivers Big Wood River water to the Bellevue Farms Subdivision, but is too far from the place of use to be practical any more. A new well will be drilled on the east side of the property near the ditch pump that pressurizes the sprinkler system. The new well will be located 2 1/2 miles SE of Bellevue on the west side of the Gannett/Picabo Road. Protests may be submitted based on the criteria of Sec 42-222, Idaho Code. Protests against approval must be filed with IDWR, Southern Region, 1341 Fillmore St.-Suite 200; Twin Falls, ID 83301 with a protest fee of \$25.00 for each application on or before April 26, 2004. The protestant must also send a copy of the protest to the applicant.
