- 1. The water right(s) referenced above is accepted into the bank and rented in accordance with a private agreement formulated between the lessor and the renter. These leased rights were donated to the Idaho Water Resource Board for the purpose of restoring stream flow in Sulphur Creek and the Pahsimeroi River. The IWRB approved \$12,305 for administration through WD 73, of which 10%, or \$1,230.50, can go to the Bank.
- 2. Under this negotiated lease and rental agreement, there is no payment to the lessor.
- 3. While a right is in the bank, the lessor may <u>not</u> use the right without approval of the department even if the right is not rented from the bank. Any violation of the terms of this lease may result in enforcement procedures pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-351 for illegal diversion and use of water and may include civil penalties pursuant to Idaho Code § 42-1701B.
- 4. A right accepted into the bank stays in the bank until the Board releases it, the lease term expires, or upon request from the lessor to change the term of the lease.
- 5. While a water right is in the bank, forfeiture provisions are stayed.

- 6. Rental of water under this right is subject to the limitations and conditions of approval of the water right.
- 7. Failure of the right holder to comply with the conditions of acceptance is cause for the Director to rescind acceptance of the lease.
- 8. Acceptance of a right into the bank does not, in itself, confirm the validity of the right or any elements of the water right, or improve the status of the right including the notion of resumption of use. It does not preclude the opportunity for review of the validity of this water right in any other department application process.
- 9. In accordance with Idaho Code § 42-248 and 42-1409(6), all owners of water rights are required to notify the department of any changes in mailing address or change in ownership of all or part of a water right. Notice must be provided within 120 days of the change.
- 10. Upon acceptance of a water right into the Board's water supply bank, the owner of the right may withdraw the right within thirty (30) days of acceptance into the bank if the owner does not agree with the conditions of acceptance.
- 11. The water right(s) is leased to the bank subject to all prior water rights and shall be administered in accordance with Idaho law and applicable rules of the Department of Water Resources.
- 12. The rights listed below are limited to the irrigation of a combined total of 103.6 acres in a single irrigation season. Combined Right Nos.: 73-12206, 73-12207, 73-12208, 73-12209, 73-12210, and 73-12211.
- 13. After the deduction of this lease, the rights listed below are limited to the irrigation of a combined total of 951.1 acres in a single irrigation season. Combined Right Nos.: 73-2B, 73-7A, 73-7B, 73-8B, 73-113, 73-140, 73-2164, 73-7000, 73-12206, 73-12207, 73-12208, 73-12209, 73-12210, and 73-12211.
- 14. This right is limited to the irrigation of 17.4 acres within the place of use described above in a single irrigation season.
