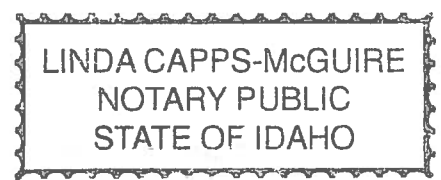

The purpose of the transfer is to change a portion of the above rights as follows: Transfer proposes to add a third point of diversion (well) and creates a permissible place of use for two ground water rights currently used to irrigate 258 acres (4.1 cfs & 1,032 af) on a farm located approximately 0.5 miles northeast of the center of Malta. The proposed well is to be located 0.25 miles north and 0.25 miles east of the center of Malta. The proposed permissible place of use is to add adjacent acres to allow flexibility in irrigation practices.

A & B IRRIGATION DISTRICT, PO BOX 675, RUPERT, ID 83350-0675 has filed Application No. 77744 for changes to the following water rights within JEROME and MINIDOKA County (s): Right No(s). 36-2080, 36-15192, 36-15127A, 36-15127B, 36-15193A, 36-15193B, 36-15195A, 36-15195B, 36-15196A, 36-15196B, 36-15194A, 36-15194B. The purpose of the transfer is to change a portion of the above rights as follows: Transfer proposes adding a new well to be drilled, removing a well as an authorized point of diversion, and correcting the legal description of a recently drilled well within the A & B Irrigation District system. The new well to be drilled is located approximately 8.8 miles west and 3.0 miles north of Rupert and will be limited to the diversion of 3.0 cfs for use in the A & B Irrigation District system. Currently 12 water rights allow for the diversion of up to 1100.0 cfs from 193 authorized diversion points (wells) located in Jerome and Minidoka counties for the irrigation of up to 66,686.2 acres within the system. The application will allow for the continued diversion of water from 193 authorized points of diversion to maintain the overall production capacity of the A & B Irrigation District system. Permits will be subject to all prior water rights.
