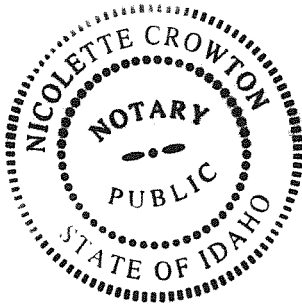

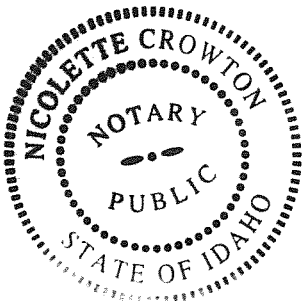

Application also proposes to use portions of the Fish Creek channel (located approximately 1.1 to 7.4 miles N & 4.1 to 6.6 miles E of Carey) and a drainage gallery (located approximately 0.8 to 1.1 miles N & 4.1 to 4.3 miles E of Carey) for groundwater recharge from storage.
