Re: Amended Water Supply Bank Applications for Jentzsch-Kearl Farms

Dear Monica,

Brockway Engineering, on behalf of Jentzsch-Kearl Farms, submitted applications to lease portions of several water rights to the Idaho Water Supply Bank in December of 2008 and in August of 2010. Response letters from the Idaho Water Supply Bank were received stating water right applications dealing with water rights 36-7216, 36-8595, 36-13065A, 36-15170A, 36-16553 and 37-793 could not be accepted by the WSB due to "stacking" of these water rights with other water rights or for other reasons. Portions of additional stacked water rights or alternative water rights were identified through conversations with you and Pam Skaggs; those portions of those rights as well as amended portions of the water rights listed above are included in this amended WSB submittal package.

Attached are twelve (12) water supply bank applications for property owned and or leased by Jentzsch-Kearl Farms. All applications seek to place excess irrigation water into the water supply bank for 5 years starting on October 15th 2010.

The water supply bank application for water right 37-793 was returned to the water right owner, Black Canyon Bliss. The return of this water right application to the applicant by IDWR was an error as agreed upon in a recent conversation with you. Because Brockway Engineering submitted the original application and that application was returned to the owner of the water right, the application for 37-793 is being re-submitted by our office.

WSB applications for water rights 36-196, 36-15536 and 36-16555 have been included; applications for these three water rights were not submitted earlier this year. A WSB application for 36-15536 identifying 11.6 acres for lease was submitted to your office in 2008. The attached lease application for water right 36-15536 is intended to supersede the 2008 application.

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Also included are applications for water rights 36-8624 (stacked with 36-16553), 36-2635 and 36-11328 (stacked with 36-7216), 36-2453A (stacked with 36-13065A), and 36-8205 (replaces previous 2010 WSB application submittal for permit 36-8595). We ask to withdraw the application submitted in 2010 for water right 36-16554 as the 17 acres associated with the water right have been enrolled in the CREP program and are not eligible to be leased to the WSB. Jentzsch-Kearl Farms expects to remove the leased water from the Idaho Water Supply Bank when lands become available for irrigation and or when the water can be transferred to the new location for permanent irrigation use.

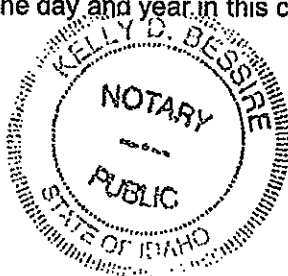
