United Water uses approximately 110 water rights at approximately 85 points of diversion (wells and two surface water treatment plants) to meet customer demand in its contiguous service area as defined by the Idaho PUC.

If yes, describe. Water will be supplied from the well associated with 63-12363 (Cassia #2) and other United Water municipal supply wells that pump into the contiguous distribution system.
