Dear Applicant(s):

The Department of Water Resources has received your water right application. Preliminary review of the application indicates that it is incomplete and cannot be accepted for processing. We are returning your application to allow you to complete the necessary items. The required information is described below.

The Ownership of point of diversion. The point of diversion is on Dale Jolley's property according to your application and the tax lot information. The Department requires a written agreement between you and Mr. Jolley to allow you to use the point of diversion on his property.

The Ownership of place of use. The place of use is listed for 6 acres. Of that 6 acres, you only own 1 acre and Mr. Jolley owns 5.8 acres of the place of use you have submitted on your application according to the tax lot information. There are two ways you can correct this place of use. You, the Tarkalson's can file on your 1 acre and Mr. Jolley can file on for his portion of his property or, you file on the whole 6 acres and again you will need a land agreement between you and Mr. Jolley.

Please re-submit your application along with the information being requested on this letter within 30 days from the date you received this letter. If you do not respond within 30 days, IDWR may void your application and refund your money.
