NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGE TO WATER RIGHTS

Notice is hereby given that an Application for Transfer has been filed with the Idaho Department of Water Resources for changes to water rights within Gooding County: **DAVID J. & REBECCA L. TUPPER, 1114 E 2700 S; HAGERMAN ID 83332** filed Application No. **71901** on 4/14/05. Transfer application filed to change a 3.1-acre irrigation portion of two overlapping water rights diverted from Tupper Spring to commercial use associated with a water bottling facility located approximately 1.75 miles due east of the south end of Hagerman. Three points of diversion from Tupper Spring will be utilized to provide water for the water bottling facility, stockwater, domestic, and fish propagation uses associated with the two water rights. Protests may be submitted based on the criteria of Sec 42-222, Idaho Code. The protestant must also send a copy of the protest to the applicant.
