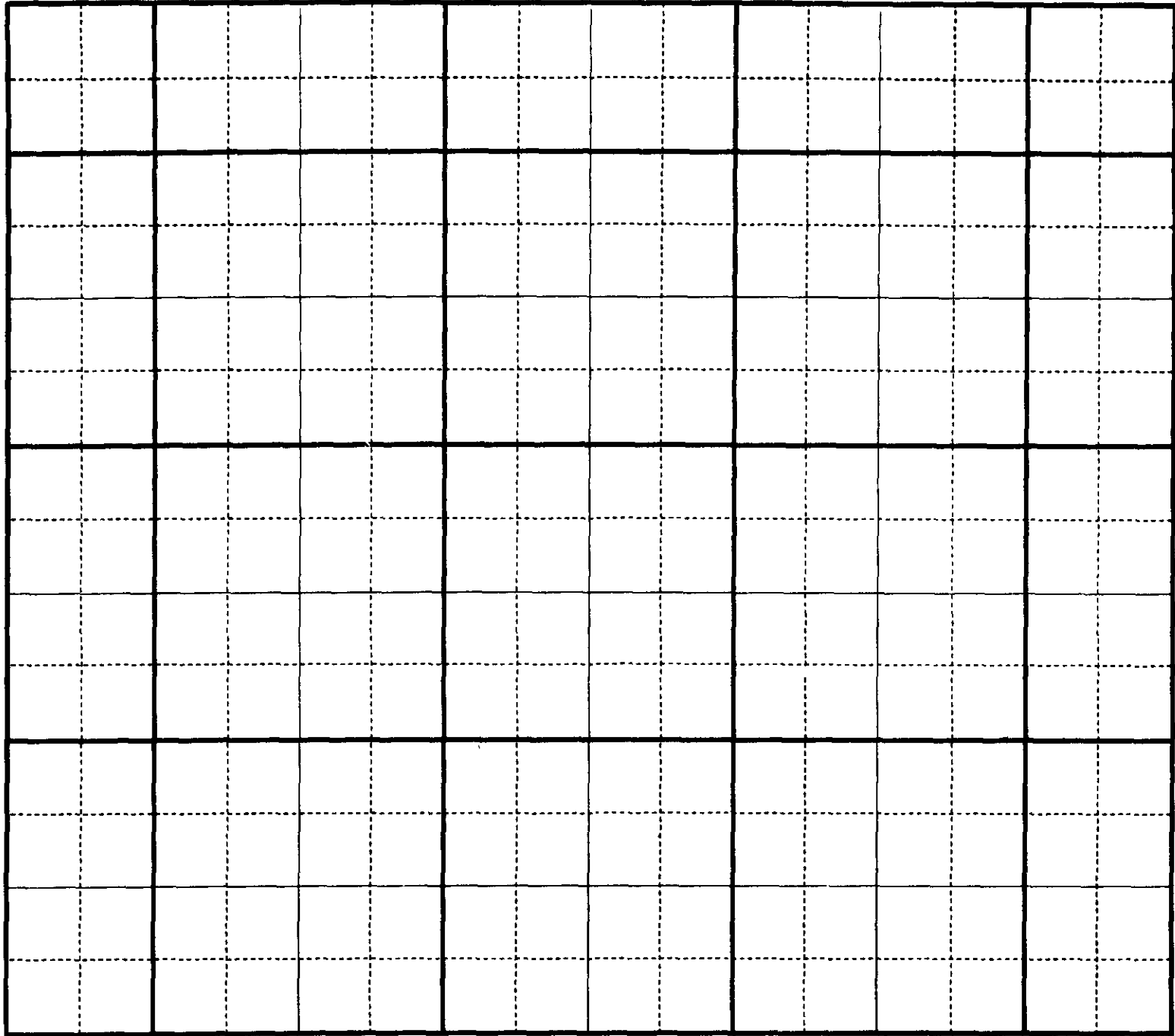


Diagram of System
