The water for this permit is pumped from Adair Creek in the NW 1/4 - SE 1/4 - NE 1/4
of section 9. township 12N - range 15E (approximately 120 feet from where Adair Creek
enters Yankee Fork). The water is then diverted through a 3 Hp pump into a flexible hose
to a trommel (approximately 50 feet northeast of pump). The water is then run through the
trommel and a slush box to separate the gold from the rocks, sand, and other debris. The
water is then diverted into a settling pond at the end of the trommel where it is kept until
it seeps out or is evaporated.
The time spent working the mine varies from year to year depending on the price of
gold and the amount of time Mr. Stricklan has available to use this claim. It was understood
that he spends approximately 100 days at the mine per year using the water about 8 hours
a day when he is working a peak production.

I am writing in response to your letter of January 22, 1992, regarding the above referenced Permit.

As I understand the facts, you have an approved Permit to appropriate 1.0 cubic feet per second (cfs) of water from Adair Creek for mining purposes. Your project is in the development phase and the time within which to submit proof of beneficial use has been extended to July 1, 1992.

Your question concerns the method used to divert the water and the plan of your system. You may use whatever means you chose to divert the water, as long as you stay within the parameters the Permit authorizes. You cannot expand the amount of water diverted, or the period or type of use. You need to stay within the legal descriptions of the points of diversion and place of use or you would be required to file an Amendment to the Permit to reflect the changes. 
After the project is completed and Proof of Beneficial Use has been filed, a representative from the Department will conduct a field exam. The License will be based upon the field exam and the development completed at that time.


