WHEREAS, the Department notified the permit holder by certified mail that proof was due and instructed the permit holder of the steps to be taken to submit the proof of beneficial use; and,



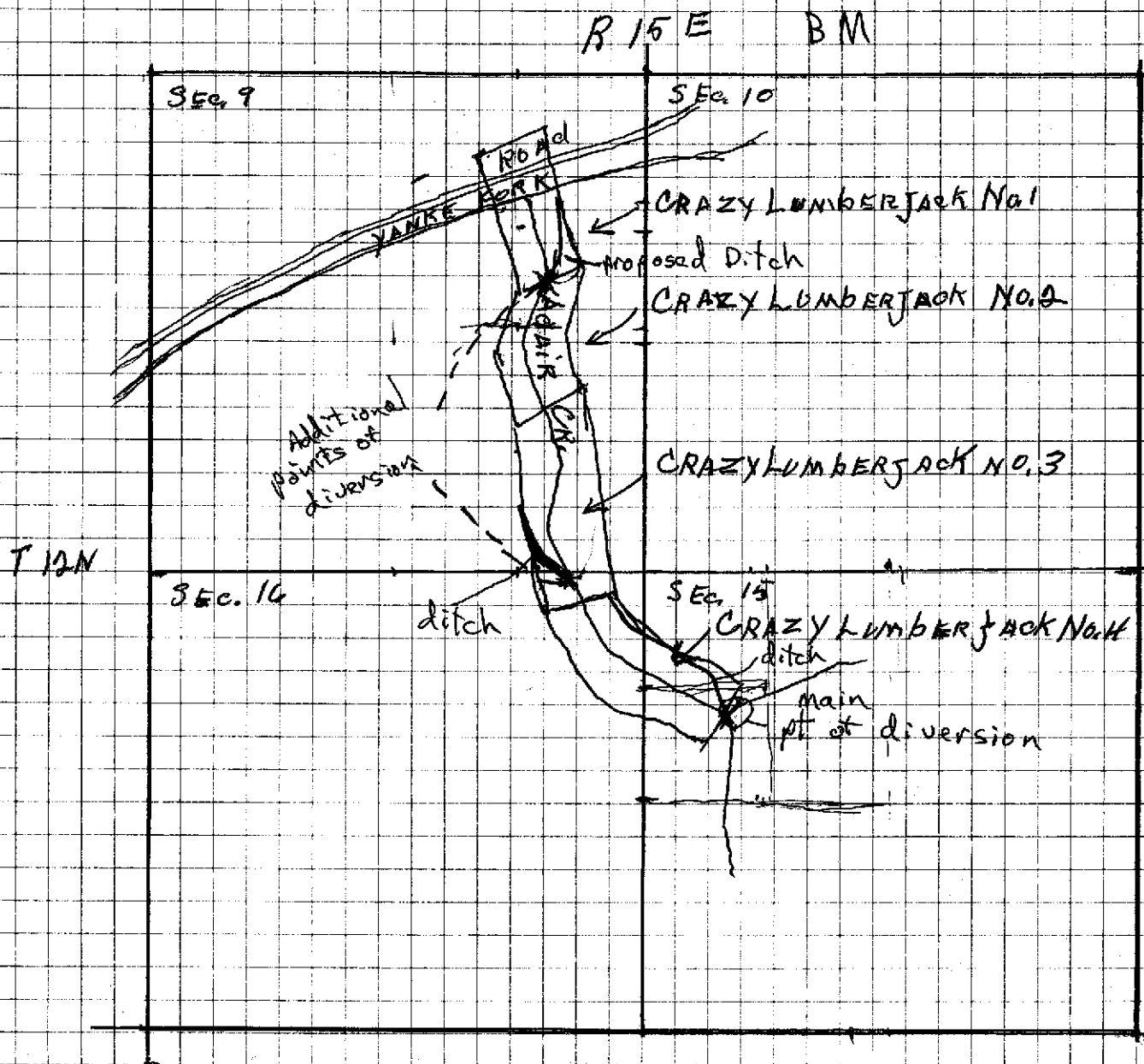

### ACTION OF THE DIRECTOR, DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES

This is to certify that I have examined Application for Permit to appropriate the public waters of the State of Idaho No. 72-7392, and said application is hereby APPROVED.

1. Approval of said application is subject to the following limitations and conditions:

a. SUBJECT TO ALL PRIOR WATER RIGHTS.

b. Proof of construction of works and application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before January 1, 19 90.

c. The rate of diversion, if water is to be used for irrigation under this permit, when combined with all other water rights for the same land shall not exceed 0.02 cubic feet per second for each acre of land.

d. The water right acquired under this permit if for hydropower purposes shall be junior and subordinate to all rights to the use of water, other than hydropower, within the State of Idaho that are initiated later in time than the priority of this permit and shall not give rise to any right or claim against any future rights to the use of water, other than hydropower, within the State of Idaho initiated later in time than the priority of this permit.

e. Other: Permit holder shall commence the excavation or construction of diverting works within one year of the date this permit is issued and shall proceed diligently until the project is complete.

The issuance of this permit in no way grants any right-of-way or easement across the land of another.

A measuring device of a type approved by the Department shall be permanently installed and maintained as part of the diverting works.

In the event that water used under this permit should be discharged into a natural channel, settling ponds will be required which are capable of reducing the silt load to such a level that the quality of the water would not be impaired for other beneficial uses.

Water used under this permit if discharged into a natural channel or subsurface system shall meet Idaho Water Quality Standards.

**E. NARRATIVE/REMARKS/COMMENTS**

The water for this permit is pumped from Adair Creek in the NW 1/4 - SE 1/4 - NE 1/4 of section 9, township 12N - range 15E (approximately 120 feet from where Adair Creek enters Yankee Fork). The water is then diverted through a 3 Hp pump into a flexible hose to a trommel (approximately 50 feet northeast of pump). The water is then run through the trommel and a slush box to separate the gold from the rocks, sand, and other debris. The water is then diverted into a settling pond at the end of the trommel where it is kept until it seeps out or is evaporated.

The time spent working the mine varies from year to year depending on the price of gold and the amount of time Mr. Stricklan has available to use this claim. It was understood that he spends approximately 100 days at the mine per year using the water about 8 hours a day when he is working a peak production.

As I understand the facts, you have an approved Permit to appropriate 1.0 cubic feet per second (cfs) of water from Adair Creek for mining purposes. Your project is in the development phase and the time within which to submit proof of beneficial use has been extended to July 1, 1992.


