



Notice is by given that five (5) applications have been filed with the Department of Water Resources for changes to water rights in Custer County as described below:

AMENDED Transfer No. 5534 by Stephen &/or Lyndella Bauchman. 3730 Pama Lane; Las Vegas NV 89120 involves two rights diverting from Darling Creek tribu-tary to Challis Creek within SESW, S05 for irrigation of a 76 acre permissible place of use; Right No. 72-00189A (0.79 cfs) is recorded with priority date of 05/ 01/1879 & Right No. 72-10246A (1.03 cfs) is recorded with priority date of 04/15/1912. The purpose of this transfer is to correctly record diversion points within SWSE, S05 and NWNW, S09; all T14N, R19E.

Transfer No. 5710 by Lynn T. Stevenson, PO Box 367: CHALLIS ID 83326 involves Right No. 72-10471B (0.06 cfs) recorded with priority date of 07/22/1910 from Challis Creek tributary to Salmon River within Lot 10 (NWNW), S07 and rediverted within NWSW, S08 for irrigation of 2.0 acres within NWSW, S08. The applicant requests to re-locate point of rediversion to site within NENWSW, (190' down the canal from original rediversion point) S08; all T14N, R19E.

Burchill, PO Box 291, Challis ID 83226 involves two rights: Right No. 72-07431 (0.03 cfs) recorded with priority date of 11/30/1989 from Springs tributary to Pats Creek within SESW, S33, T15N, R18E and used for stockwater (0.02 cfs), domestic (0.03 cfs) and irrigation (0.03 cfs) of 3 acres within Lot 3 (NENW), S04, T14N, R18E. Right No. 72-10044 (1.70 cfs) recorded with priority date of 10/10/1911 from Pats Creek tributary to Challis
Creek Bear Creek tributary to Bear Creek. Challis Creek, Challis Creek tributary to Salmon River with 4 diversion points within Lot 7, (NENW) and SWNW, S04, T14N, R18E for irrigation of 43 acres within S04, T14N, R18E. The applicants propose to divert a combined total of 0.23 cfs from a Spring tributary to Pats Creek within SESESW and Pats Creek tributary to Bear Creek within SWSESW both S33, T15N, R18E. Diversions also include White Valley Creek tributary to Bear Creek within NWNENE, S05, T14N, R18E. Combined irrigation uses (0.23 cfs) cover 13.5 acres within NW, S04, T14N, R18E with domestic use (0.03 cfs) and stockwater use (0.02 cfs) at the same location.


Any protest against the proposed changes must be filed with

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL AND REMARKS

- 3. The right holder shall comply with all fish screening requirements of the Idaho Department of Fish and Game.
- 4. Use of water under this water right will be regulated by the watermaster of State Water District No. 72C.
- 5. Prior to diversion of water under this approval, the right holder shall provide a means of measurement and lockable controlling works for all authorized points of diversion. The means of measurement and controlling works must be suitable for control of the diversions and acceptable to the watermaster.
- 6. All water rights within Basin 72 are from connected sources of water in the Snake River Basin and shall be administered conjunctively.
- 7. Approval of Transfer 5534 does not confirm Claimed Right 72-10246A.
- 8. Right 72-00189A and 72-10246A are diverted through the points of diversion described above.
- 9. Rights 72-00189A and 72-10246A when combined shall not exceed the irrigation of 76 acres.
- * 10. When applied exclusively through a pressurized sprinkler system, Rights 72-00189A, 72-10246A, and any other rights appurtenant to the place of use described above, shall provide no more than 0.02 cfs per acre nor more than 3.5 afa per acre for irrigation of the lands described above.

EXPLANATORY INFORMATION TO ACCOMPANY A PRELIMINARY ORDER

The accompanying order or approved document is a "Preliminary Order" issued by the department pursuant to section 67-5243, Idaho Code. It can and will become a final order without further action of the Department of Water Resources (department) unless a party petitions for reconsideration, files an exception and brief, or requests a hearing as further described below:

PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION

Any party may file a petition for reconsideration of a preliminary order with the department within fourteen (14) days of the service date of this order. The department will act on a petition for reconsideration within twenty-one (21) days of its receipt, or the petition will be considered denied by operation of law. See Section 67-5243(3) Idaho Code.

EXCEPTIONS AND BRIEFS

Within fourteen (14) days after (a) the service date of a preliminary order, (b) the service date of a denial of a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, or (c) the failure within twenty-one (21) days to grant or deny a petition for reconsideration from this preliminary order, any party may in writing support or take exceptions to any part of a preliminary order and may file briefs in support of the party's position on any issue in the proceeding with the Director. Otherwise, this preliminary order will become a final order of the agency.

REQUEST FOR HEARING

Unless a right to a hearing before the department or the Idaho Water Resource Board (Board) is otherwise provided by statute, any person aggrieved by any final decision, determination, order or action of the Director of the department and who has not previously been afforded an opportunity for a hearing on the matter may request a hearing pursuant to section 42-1701A(3), Idaho Code. A written petition contesting the action of the Director and requesting a hearing shall be filed within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the denial or conditional approval.

ORAL ARGUMENT

If the Director grants a petition to review the preliminary order, the Director shall allow all parties an opportunity to file briefs in support of or taking exceptions to the preliminary order and may schedule oral argument in the matter before issuing a final order. If oral arguments are to be heard, the Director will within a reasonable time period notify each party of the place, date and hour for the argument of the case. Unless the Director orders otherwise, all oral arguments will be heard in Boise. Idaho.

The Director will issue a final order within fifty-six (56) days of receipt of the written briefs, oral argument or response to briefs, whichever is later, unless waived by the parties or for good cause shown. The department will serve a copy of the final order on all parties of record.

Section 67-5246(5), Idaho Code, provides as follows:







Today I spoke with ranch operator Eric Matson. He told me that they used to have two ditches from Darling Creek. The gravity diversion listed in Part 1 of the application serves the high ditch, which irrigated land north and east of the proposed pump diversion. The p/d I viewed with the watermaster last month serves the low ditch, which irrigated land more east of the pump station along Challis Creek. The SRBA recognized only the high ditch as serving this ranch. The applicant plans to replace the high ditch with a sprinkler system served by the pump, keeping the low ditch for gravity irrigation. I understood that they wanted to keep a gravity diversion as a backup in case the pump failed, but what Matson told me today contradicted this idea. I have prepared an amended transfer based on keeping the lower diversion and adding the pump.

We also talked about the diversion from Challis Creek that used to run high water into Darling Creek. Matson said that he had been on this property for 6 years but had never seen this diversion used. So the right to do this may have been lost. But it is for high water only, so maybe other water user would not care. He said they might want to use this diversion in the future, but did not ask me to list it on the amended transfer (it was not recommended by SRBA, & was not listed on the original transfer). I told Eric that they might not be able to add it to their rights in the future if it is not recognized now.

Matson also said that the land in Sec. 8 west of the pump site sub irrigates (neither of the above ditches serves it). But the transfer does not ask to change the recommended p/u, so this is probably not an issue that we can deal with here.

I have tried unsuccessfully to contact you by telephone on this matter, so I am writing to you in order to clarify certain facts. I visited the Bauchman property a couple of weeks ago with Jack Challis in order to verify the location of your gravity diversion from Darling Creek. The headgate he showed me was just north of your property line in Sec. 5 just before the two channels of Darling Creek rejoin. This diversion would provide water to the low ditch that runs through the valley floor north of Darling Creek, but this ditch appears to rejoin Darling Creek just above your new pump station alongside Challis Creek; is this correct?

The diversion point for the high ditch further north appears to be at the base of a small earth dam lying northwest of the northwest corner of the Bauchman property in Sec. 8. This ditch runs further north and higher up the hillside than the low ditch, and appears to be the only one capable of reaching the Bauchman land east of the new pump site and north of Challis Creek; is this correct?

Jack also told me that you divert water from Challis Creek into Darling Creek, but that the diversion washed out a year or two ago. This diversion was not listed on the transfer or recommended in the SRBA. Do you plan to use this diversion in the future? If you want this diversion and additional water source for your Darling Creek right covered by the SRBA, Mr. Bauchman should write to the SRBA Court (PO Box 2707, Twin Falls, ID, 83303) to request that the recommendation be corrected. Although I did not visit this diversion with Jack, it appears to be located in the NW/NW/NW Sec. 8 T. 14N R. 19E.

Last Friday I visited the existing gravity diversion and the new pumping plant accompanied by Watermaster Jack Challis. Darling Creek comes out of the hills in a generally south direction before turning southeast. It runs southeasterly a little ways, then splits into 2 branches. The point where the split occurs is probably what the SRBA considers the point of diversion, but this occurs to be incorrect. Jack told me that he thought that the south channel might have been created to provide stockwater for the landowner in Sec. 8, but wasn't sure. He couldn't find any manmade controlling works at the split. Anyway, the 2 branches runs more-or-less parallel along the section line/fenceline, with one branch on each side of the line. The area is very brushy and overgrown, so what is there has been there for a long time. The north channel is much deeper than the south channel, so could be original channel. But the split could just as easily been created by natural flooding, so it is hard to say why there are two channels here. The Baughman gravity diversion is on the north channel in the SW/SW/SE Sec. 5 based on the GIS map as annotated by Jack. The south channel crosses the line into Sec. 5 and rejoins the north channel just past this diversion. Since this is the first identifiable manmade structure in this part of Darling Creek, it appears reasonable to call this the p/d, so I recommend that the application be changed to reflect this.

With regard to the pump site, Jack told me that Darling Creek has always dead-ended in a boggy area alongside Challis Creek, without actually running into Challis Creek on the surface. Bauchman dug out a short channel in this bog, and has placed a pumping plant and mainline for sprinklers in this channel. Two overflow pipes allow any excess water to run into Challis Creek. This site has been GPS'd by Bob Foster (A007596), so there does not appear to be any question as to its location. We parked near this site and walked into the upper diversion, and it was obvious that Darling Creek runs in a separate channel instead of dumping right into Challis Creek as shown on the USGS map.

Darling Creek is a very small stream, so pumping it through sprinklers makes a lot more sense than trying to run a long ditch through the farm. The application does not propose to change the place of use as determined in the SRBA, so I did not try to verify the irrigated land. The watermaster does not oppose this transfer, so I recommend that it be approved.

I have just spent most of the afternoon with Mr. Allen Stranger, employee of Challis Creek Cattle Company (Steve & Lyndella Bauchman). We walked the entire area in an effort to check what you sent me (and the Bauchman's apparently were to have included) in the subject application. This is how I see the situation.

The Bauchman Darling Creek diversion they (and prior owners) have used in the past (and I understand the Bauchmans want to retain as an alternate POD should the new pump diversion be "down" for any length of time; what I further understand was to have been assigned GPS I.D. No. A0002596), is NOT, in my opinion, where you show it on your map (copy enclosed). I have indicated where I think it is located with a red "X" and red arrow pointing to it. The white line running from this POD north of the Section 5/Section 8 and Section 4/Section 9 dividing lines is the ditch location fed from this POD. Flow would, of course, be south out of or from that ditch.

The "diversion" you point out (and identify with a yellow box with an "X" in it marked 1; Existing Headgate) is, in my opinion, a split in the Darling Creek flow that simply returns to the main Darling Creek channel just below where the actual diversion (and headgate) is located. I have identified this split with the white line I have drawn on the map (south of the Section 5/Section 8 dividing line). I could not even find where much, if any, flow from this "split" could have been directed to the point of use designated on the map south of the Section 5/Section 8 dividing line though I am sure some benefit could have been realized at various times.

MICROFILMED

Since I was with Tim Luke and Bob Foster when the new pump diversion, GPS I.D. No. A0007596, was "shot", I must assume the computer generating this map stipulated this GPS location and the pump is actually located where it is shown. This is, of course, NOT where it is shown on the contour map attached to the application. Again, it is my opinion your map shows the correct location.

Jim, with regard to the Recommendation Of Watermaster enclosed with the copy of the application you sent me, I do not oppose approval of this application. Frankly, I favored their use of this diversion during this process rather than them lose their crop. Be that as it may, I still do not oppose approval but simply provide the information herein to insure we make every effort to get it right the first time.

Please let me know if there are any questions and/or if you would like me to do anything further.

There is confusion over the location of the new p/d due to an apparent change in the channel of Darling Creek. The quad map and other maps show that this stream runs in a southeasterly direction before dumping into Challis Cr. in the NE/NW S. 8. But watermaster Jack Challis told me that Darling Creek turns to the east at the mouth of its canyon, running about 3/4 mile thru the south end of Sec. 5 & 4 before joining Challis Creek in the NW/NW Sec. 9. While there are some darker lines thru a vegetated area where Darling Creek originally ran, the GIS tif data is not conclusive as to the location of this stream. While Bob Foster did GPS the pump site, Jack said that he was having trouble getting a reading due possibly to weak batteries. The location of the gravity diversion from Darling Creek (as determined by SRBA) supports Jack's statement about the location of this stream, since it is well away from the mapped channel. The old P/D is SRBA #122, which the applicant wants to keep as a backup diversion in case of pump problems. application appears to be correct with regard to the location of the two diversions.

Our office has become aware of a newly installed pump within the SWNENW of S08 T14N, R19E on Darling Creek which is reported to be owned or operated by you. Our records do not show that this is an authorized point of diversion for your rights 72-10246A and 72-00189A. I request your cooperation in:

-identifying what water right covers this diversion if our records are not correct. and/or

-file a transfer application to record the newly developed point of diversion. (Please find enclosed a transfer application with instructions for your possible use.)

Please respond to our office within 14 days of the date of this letter as to the status of your project.

Please note that to divert water in Idaho without a valid water right is illegal pursuant to §42-351, Idaho Code and subject to civil penalties of up to \$300 per acre irrigated. Please also note that alteration of a stream without a Stream Channel Alteration Permit is also a violation and may also be subject to civil penalties.

By copy of this letter to Jack Challis, the watermaster on Challis Creek, I will instruct him not to allow diversion at this new point of diversion until this matter is resolved.

I have enclosed photographs and a map showing the location of the above mentioned pump that Tim Luke, Jack Challis, and I inspected last month. Jack Challis, Watermaster 72-C, stated the pump had been installed in the fall of 1998.

A check of department records shows the POD for the above rights located in the SESESW of S05 T14N R19E. The pump is located in the SWNENW of S08 T14N R19E. I was unable to find any record of a transfer application proposing to change the POD.

I have instructed the watermaster to inform the wateruser or his agent not to operate the pump until this matter was resolved.

There may be other issues involved with this diversion such as a possible SCA violation with the installation of the pump directly in the channel of Darling Creek. It also appears that water could also be diverted from Challis Creek if so desired to the ground covered by the Darling Creek rights.

We probably need to contact the wateruser and request they file a transfer application for the change in the POD and Terry Blau may want to look into the SCA matter.
