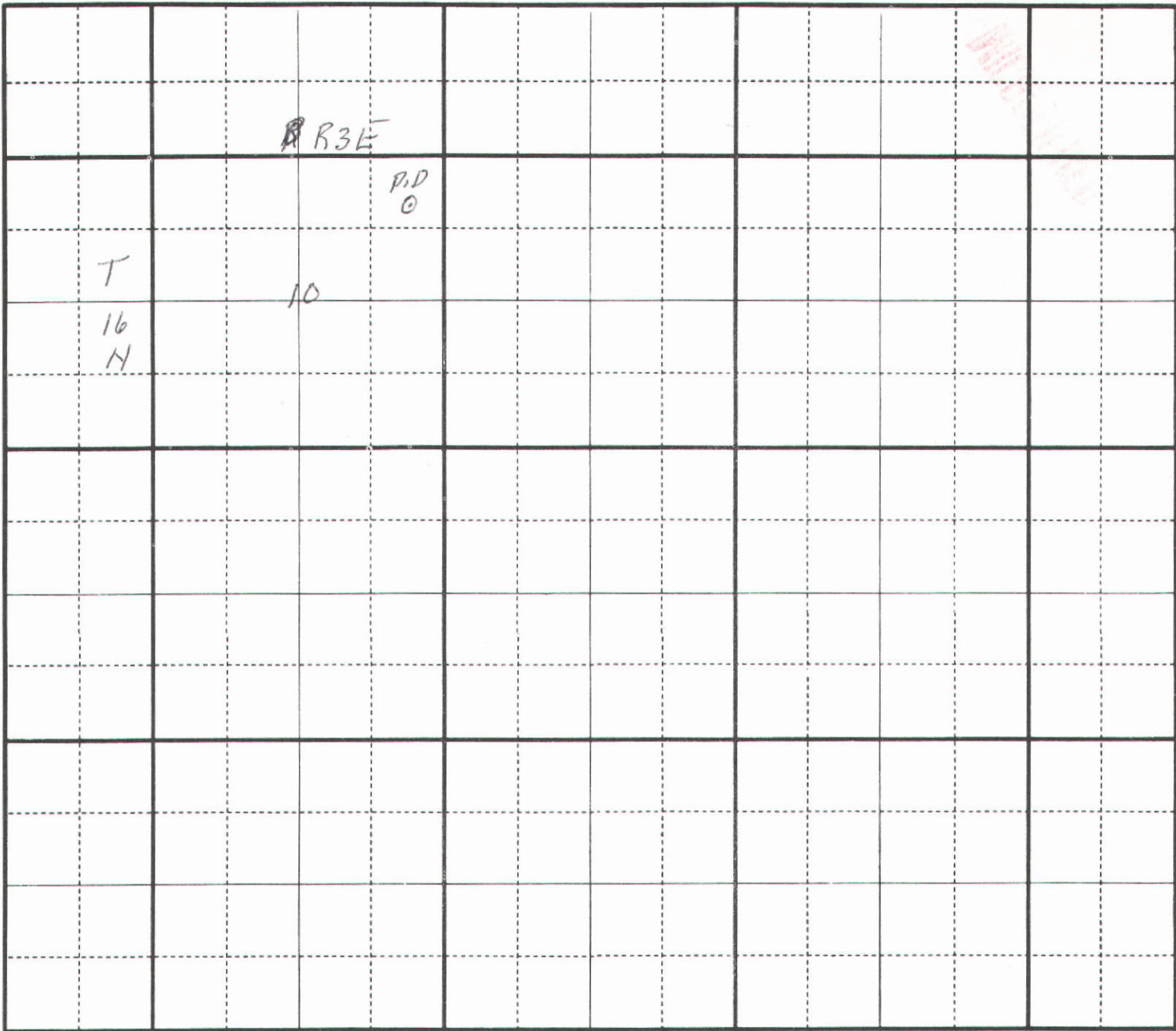


Diagram of System

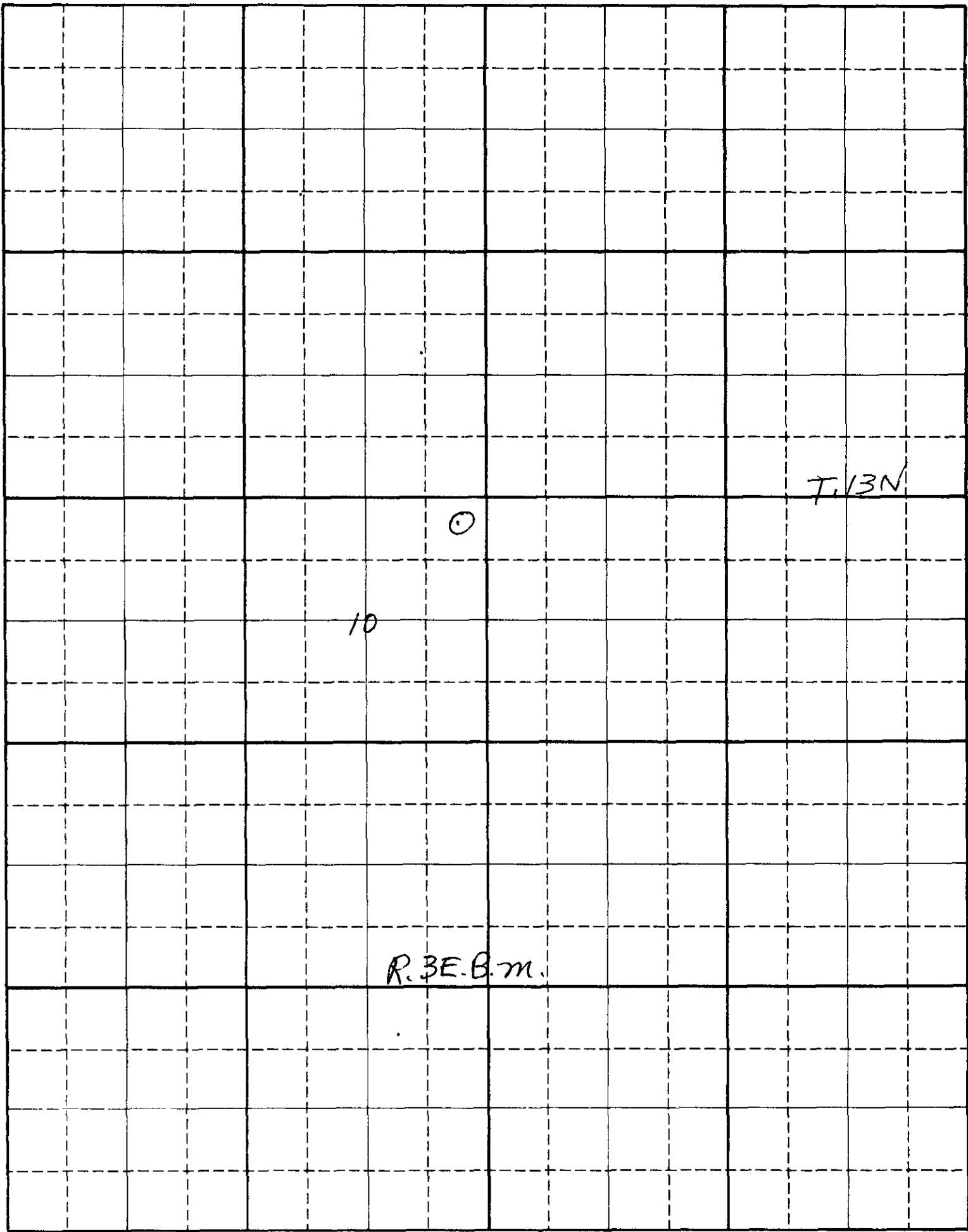

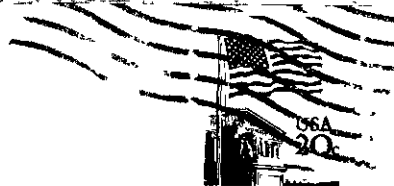
