Remarks: From the corner to sections 2 & 3, Tp. 13 S. R. 29 E. B. M. and sections 34 & 35 Tp. 12 C. R. 29 E. B. M. the North end of the dam site (for main dam mentioned above which is the reservoir dam), bears S. 63°00' W. 1900 feet distant, and from the corner to secti 8 & 9, 16 & 17, Tp. 13 S. R. 29 E. B. M. the main point of diversion from Sublette Creek bears North 30°15' E 2431 feet distant. This point of diversion is an old landmark having been used by the Sublette Creek Irrigation Company for a period of over 30 years, the creek having been divided by agreement during this time into three equal streams, two running in ditches on the North and South sides respectively and the third being permitted to run down the natural channel to a second or minor point of diversion situated S. 45°00' W. 1500 feet from the Northeast corner of Section 11, Tp. 13 S. R. 28 E. B. M. where two ditches are taken out on the North and South sides respectively. This point of diversion is also an old landmark as are these ditches as well as the ditches already mentioned, and it is not the intention of the applicant or any of its agents to interfere with or prejudice in anywise the rights acquired by this old well regulated and established system of irrigation, but by the construction of a reservoir in addition to those already in use by this company for storage purposes, by drawing the stored water from this reservoir into the Creek channel and conveying it down the said channel to the points of diversion mentioned where it is to be diverted as before into the old canals which are to be enlarged to the capacity mentioned in this application with the necessary drops and controlling works to prevent undue washing and by letting the amount of water applied for flow through the same, to more fully and systematically irrigate the lands mentioned in this application which are those belonging to the old system established since 1878, as aforesaid.

At the request of Mr. A. M. McCulloch, in charge Southeastern Idaho Mater Facilities Office, at Pocatello, Idaho, we are writing to advise you that License and Certificate of Mater Right is being issued to the Sublett Trigation Company for 17.2 second feet of the waters of Sublett Creek, for irrigation, domestic and stock matering purposes, upon 860 acres of land described as follows:

Saction 2; Saura, Elund, Sel Section 3; NEA, Nintal Section 11; Natural, Saura, Section 12; Twp. 13 Southl Renge 23 East, B. M.

Soution 7; Swi, NEISE, NISE Section 8; NWISE Section 9; Township 13 South, Range 29 East, B. M.

The original Permit No. 4938 called for 35.2 second feet, but beneficial use proof was only made on the above 860 acres, and for that reason the license can only issue for 17.2 second feet, or one inch to the acre, which is the maximum allowed by the statute.

In this connection have to advise that the Sublett Irrigation Sompany also holds Reservoir Permit No. 558 for 2390 acre feet per annum of water from Sublett Creek, with priority of February 15, 1939, on which completion of works proof will not be due until February 18, 1944.



Dear Mr. Spofford:

Enclosed is a check for \$86.00 for payment by the Sublett Irrigation Company in full for beneficial use proof on 860 acres of land, including 43 subdivisions of land. I secured this check from Mr. Adams, President of the Company, and I am mailing it myself to be certain that it gets into your hands as soon as possible.

It is my understanding that, upon receipt of this check, you will be able to issue a permit for 17.2 second feet of water from Sublett Creek.

I am attempting to get final approval from Portland this week, in order that we may mail out the invitations for bid before Saturday of this week. In connection with final approval, the Regional Attorney at Portland desires that a full explanation be made as to why the permit was issued for 17.2 second feet rather than 34.2 second feet. In order to be sure that the Portland office fully understands the conditions, I would appreciate it very much if you would compose a letter to Mr. Harry J. De Francq, Acting Regional Attorney, Office of the Solicitor, U.S.D.A., 233 Terminal Sales Building, Portland, Oregon, and verify to him that the permit for 17.2 second feet has been issued, or will be issued, based on 860 acres of land actually irrigated. I would also appreciate it if you would verify to Mr. DeFrancq that your office has approved the company's application for 2390 acre feet for storage.

I will greatly appreciate your assistance in getting the Sublett Project finally cleared for construction.

Deer Mr. Zollinger:

I received your letter of October 17th, regarding the construction of the Sublett Dam upon my neturn to Beise after making a preliminary investigation of the reconstruction of this dem.

In your letter you state that the conduit is being placed on muck, as in the old dam was no foundation. I believe this is not the case, as the new location of this conduit was made through the hillside, which without a doubt cont ins some weter. A new conduit which is surenger reinforced with stream is laid on a foundation of loose make that has been tamp into wet dirt. Sufficient set off collers are being placed around the conduit, whereby I believe it will give no further trouble.

In regard to the muck in front of the old dam, I believe that the most practicable method is followed that can be used under the conditions. Specifications, you will note, call for gravel to be used under the toe of the dam. I believe it would be just as practicable to have on this heavier meterial, as muck under this heavy meterial would certainly be tighter than gravel and will probably out out more seepage.

I believe Mr. Wilkins is very much interested in this job and is getting honest work done by the contractor.

You will admit this has been a difficult job to handle, especially under the set conditions that was experienced for a couple of weeks after the job was started. I do not believe you would be able to get anymore for your money than you are getting under this project as it is set up and operating.

I am sorry that I didnot get to see you on this trip, but due to the lateness of the time I did not stop. This office will make a third inspection of this job within a short time and will stop and discuss matters with you at that time.
