



Replying to yours of the 12th inst. would say that you should write the U.S. Land Office as to what will be required in the way of a water right when you make proof upon the land, as we could not give you this information.

In regard to your proof of use of water under your above permit would say that you can make a partial proof upon the amount of water you have already used upon the land, allowing an inch to the acre for the land under cultivation, and license will be issued for such amount. But, in order to obtain a little to the full amount of water, it would then be necessary to make a second proof of use and obtain a second license.
