

1. Examiners will not be permitted to examine any of the records in the office pertaining to this permit. They are to furnish a report of the facts and conditions as they exist, from their own observations and inquiries.
2. Always carefully note the location of the point of diversion, and accurately plat same.
3. Find out how many parties own rights in the ditch or canal and give their names and amount of right.
4. When proof is for beneficial use, carefully check up the number of acres actually irrigated in each forty and accurately plat same.
5. Make a map showing the correct location of streams and ditches, and the irrigated lands, and any adjacent permanent landmarks, such as towns, lakes, large streams and public roads.
6. If any unusual conditions are discovered, make a plain statement of them under remarks.
7. Always see the holder, if possible, and go over the whole ground with him, and make your report only upon actual existing facts and conditions.





Replying to yours of the 12th inst. would say that you should write the U.S. Land Office as to what will be required in the way of a water right when you make proof upon the land, as we could not give you this information.

In regard to your proof of use of water under your above permit would say that you can make a partial proof upon the amount of water you have already used upon the land, allowing an inch to the acre for the land under cultivation, and license will be issued for such amount. But, in order to obtain a title to the full amount of water, it would then be necessary to make a second proof of use and obtain a second license.
