Remark: Application proposes construction of a pond for fish habitat, recreation, and wildlife uses at the Suzie Q Ranch located approximately 1 mile east of Picabo. The source of the pond will be groundwater. A mitigation plan has been proposed to stop irrigation of 3.3 acres of land currently allowed under a portion of right 37-7770 diverted from groundwater. This mitigation is to compensate for evaporation losses in the new pond.

Remark: This application proposes to provide irrigation water for the new Woodside Elementary School that is being built southeast of Hailey; a new well will be drilled to provide water for irrigating 7 acres of land around the school. To mitigate for the effects of the new appropriation, a portion of an 1883 Big Wood River water right owned by the applicant will be left un-diverted in the river. The School District has also acquired a 5-acre groundwater right that will be transferred to the same land at the school; if this transfer is

approved, the amount of land irrigated under the new permit will be reduced to two acres. The new well will be located 1 3/8 miles south and 1 1/4 miles east of the curve on Hwy. 75 at the south end of Hailey. Permits will be subject to all prior water rights. Protests may be submitted based on the criteria of Sec 42-203A, Idaho Code.

PO BOX 362; BELLEVUE ID 83313-0362 filed Application for Transfer No. 71712 on 1/14/2005. Application proposes splitting right 37-8558, which is currently appurtenant to Lot 31 of Muldoon Ranch Subdivision No. 2 approximately 1.0 mile east of the center of Bellevue and making a portion of the right appurtenant to Lot 30 of Muldoon Ranch Subdivision No. 2. Right 37-8558 currently allows for the diversion of 0.09 cfs of groundwater for stockwater use and irrigation of 3.0 acres on Lot 31. The application proposes diverting 0.05 cfs from an existing well on Lot 30 for stockwater use and the irrigation of 1.6 acres within a 4.0-acre permissible Place of Use on Lot 30. The remaining portion of the right (0.04 cfs) will continue to be diverted from an existing well on Lot 31 and used for the irrigation of 1.4 acres on Lot 31. Protests may be submitted based on the criteria of Sec 42-222, Idaho Code.

An Extension of Time to Avoid Forfeiture was filed by Silver Sage Owners Association, Inc. c/o Becky Klassen, PO Box 254; KETCHUM ID 83340 on 1/25/2005. Right No. 37-8409 authorizes diversion of 0.10 cfs from groundwater for irrigation of 1.7 acres within a 15.8 acre permissible place of use from 4/15 to 10/31. This use is within the Silver Sage Subdivision. Protests may be submitted based on the criteria of Sec 42-221, Idaho Code.

Any protest against the approval of an application must be filed with the Director, Dept. of Water Resource, Southern Region, 1341 Fillmore St, Suite 200, Twin Falls ID 83301 together with a protest fee of \$25 for each application on or before 03/21/2005.
