CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL


1. Proof of application of water to beneficial use shall be submitted on or before **February 01, 2006**.
2. Subject to all prior water rights.
3. Right holder shall comply with the drilling permit requirements of Section 42-235, Idaho Code and applicable Well Construction Rules of the Department.
4. Water shall not be diverted for fire protection use under this right except to fight or repel an existing fire.
5. Use of water under this right will be regulated by a watermaster with responsibility for the distribution of water among appropriators within a water district. At the time of this approval, this water right is within State Water District No. 130.
6. Prior to the diversion and use of water under this approval, the right holder shall install and maintain acceptable measuring device, including data logger, at the authorized point of diversion and in accordance with Department specifications, or shall obtain an approved variance from the watermaster.
7. The right holder shall record the quantity of water diverted and annually report diversions of water and/or other pertinent hydrologic and system information as required by Section 42-701, Idaho Code.

8. Any license issued by IDWR pursuant to the right or portion thereof for the use of trust water is subject to a term review of 20 years after the date of this approval to determine availability of water for the use and to re-evaluate the public interest at the end of the term.
