CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

- 1 Industrial use is for mining and milling of molybdenum ore.
- 2 The use of this right is limited such that at no time shall more than 20.89 cfs be diverted at any instant from the multiple authorized points of diversion. Additionally the following limits shall apply:
Buckskin Creek limited to 8.0 cfs
Pat Hughes Creek limited to 11.0 cfs
Springs tributary to Buckskin Creek limited to 0.20 cfs
Salmon River limited to 20.89 cfs
- 3 Rights 72-07257 and 72-7193 when combined shall not exceed a total annual maximum diversion volume of 2916 af
- 4 Prior to the diversion and use of water under Transfer approval 71264, the right holder shall install and maintain acceptable measuring device(s), including data logger(s), at the authorized point(s) of diversion, in accordance with Department specifications.
- 5 Prior to the diversion and use of water under this approval, the right holder shall comply with applicable water quality standards of the Department of Environmental Quality
- 6 Place of use does not include Federal Public Lands
- 7 The right holder shall accomplish the change authorized by this transfer within one year of the date of this approval
- 8 Failure of the right holder to comply with the conditions of this transfer is cause for the Director to rescind approval of the transfer.
- 9 Pursuant to Section 42-1412(6), Idaho Code, this water right is subject to such general provisions necessary for the definition of the rights or for the efficient administration of water rights as may be determined by the Snake River Basin Adjudication court at a point in time no later than the entry of the final unified decree.

This water right is subject to all prior water rights and shall be administered in accordance with Idaho law and applicable rules of the Department of Water Resources
