NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGE TO WATER RIGHTS

Notice is hereby given that two Applications for Transfer have been filed with the Idaho Department of Water Resources for changes to water rights within Gooding County: JOSEPH D. & JOAN R. PAVKOV, 1962 E 2100 S; GOODING ID 83330 filed Application No. 71543 on 11/24/04. Transfer proposes to add a new well to an existing groundwater right that diverts 4.68 cfs for the irrigation of 280 acres on two separate farms located approximately 0.25 - 1.5 miles south and 0.5 - 2.0 miles east of the intersection of Highways 26 and 46 at the south edge of Gooding. The proposed new well will be drilled approximately 1.1 miles south and 1.0 miles east of the intersection of Highways 26 and 46. DEWEY D. & YNES V. DURFEE, 3443 S 1700 E; WENDELL ID 83355 filed Application No. 71478 on 8/23/04. Transfer proposes adding a second well, already drilled, to a system used to supply domestic and stockwater use. The property involved with the transfer is located approximately 2.5 miles west and 5.0 miles south of the center of Wendell. Protests may be submitted based on the criteria of Sec 42-222, Idaho Code. The protestant must also send a copy of the protest to the applicant.
