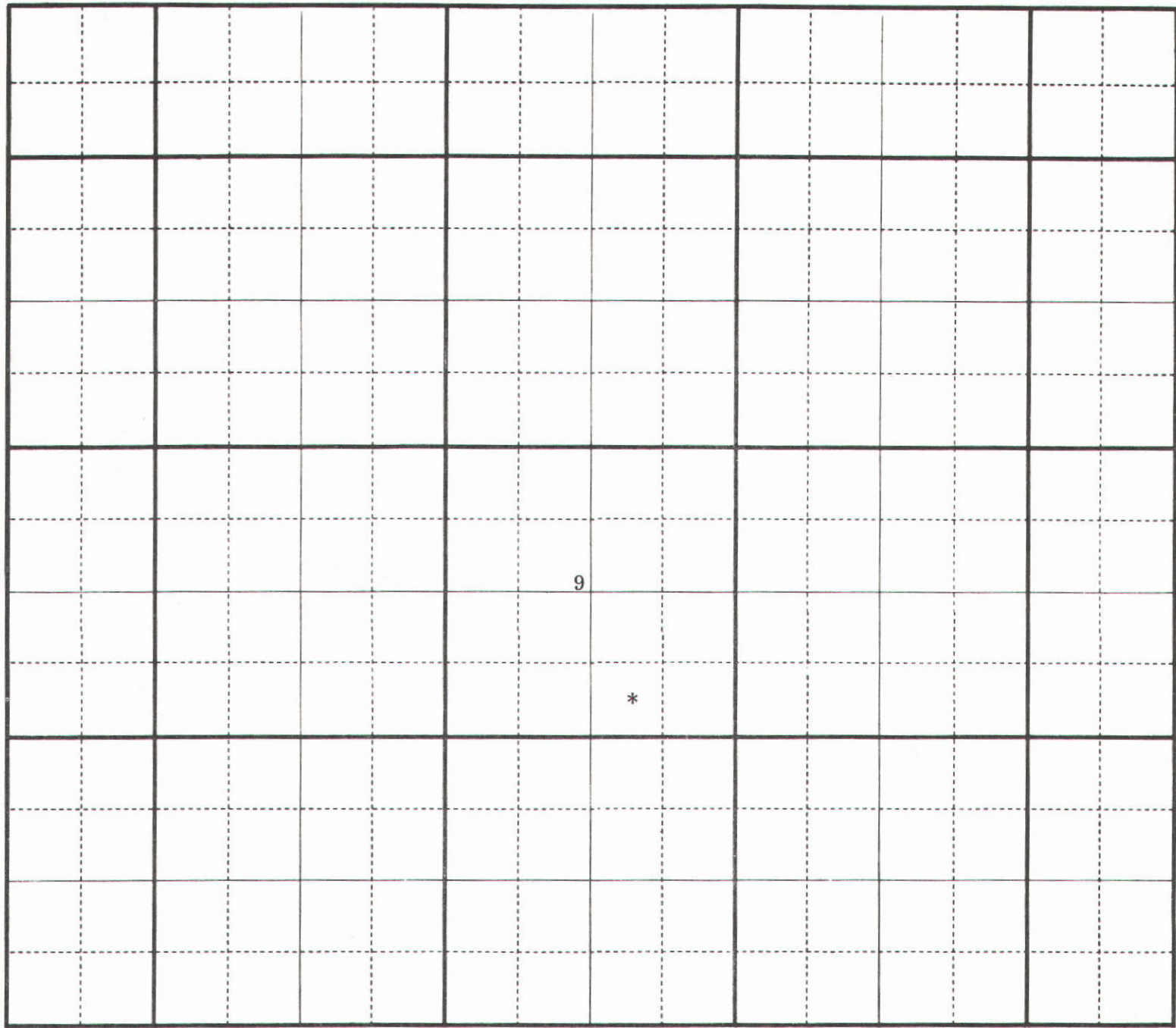
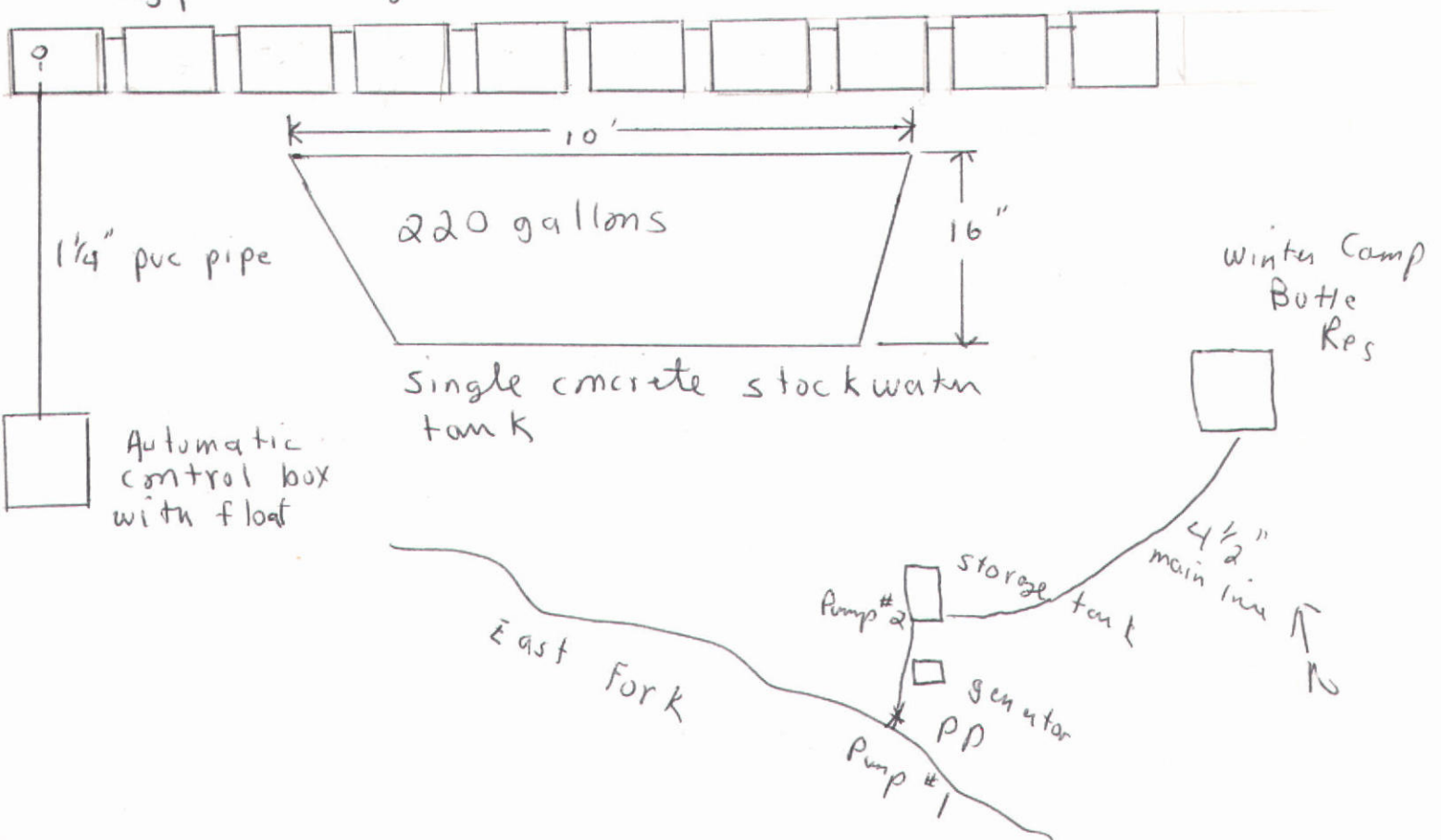


Diagram of System

SYSTEM DESCRIPTION:

Caterpillar 4 cylinder diesel engine 81 H.P., model #D330, running a caterpillar 55 KW generator (480 volts) model #5 RCR. Generator runs two pumps in water system. Pump #1 is Holloshaft motor, 30 HP, serial #R-1006558 running a Johnson vertical pump, serial #GB-4067. Pump #1 is at point of diversion on the East Fork of the Bruneau River. The diversion structure at point of diversion is a concrete catch basin with Pump #1 mounted on top. Pump #1 pumps water from the river to a concrete holding tank. From the holding tank, Pump #2, a Holloshaft 30 HP motor, serial #R-1010433, with a Johnson vertical pump, serial #GR-4066, pumps the water up to winter camp Butte Reservoir (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, T. 9 S, R. 9 E, B.M.). The reservoir stores 8.42 A.F. when full. The mainline from the holding tank to the reservoir is 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " galvanized steel pipe 2,000 feet long. Water flows from the reservoir by gravity via 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles of 4" PVC mainline pipe. The water flows to 12 sets of troughs with 10 concrete troughs per set and one metal trough. Also, on this system is the Crows Nest Lateral Pipeline, with 12 sets of 5 concrete troughs. Total storage of the whole system is 2,787,027 gallons (8.55 A.F.), excluding pipeline.

REMARKS:

To date an estimate of \$1.25 million has been spent on this system. The BLM plans to add more to this system in the future.

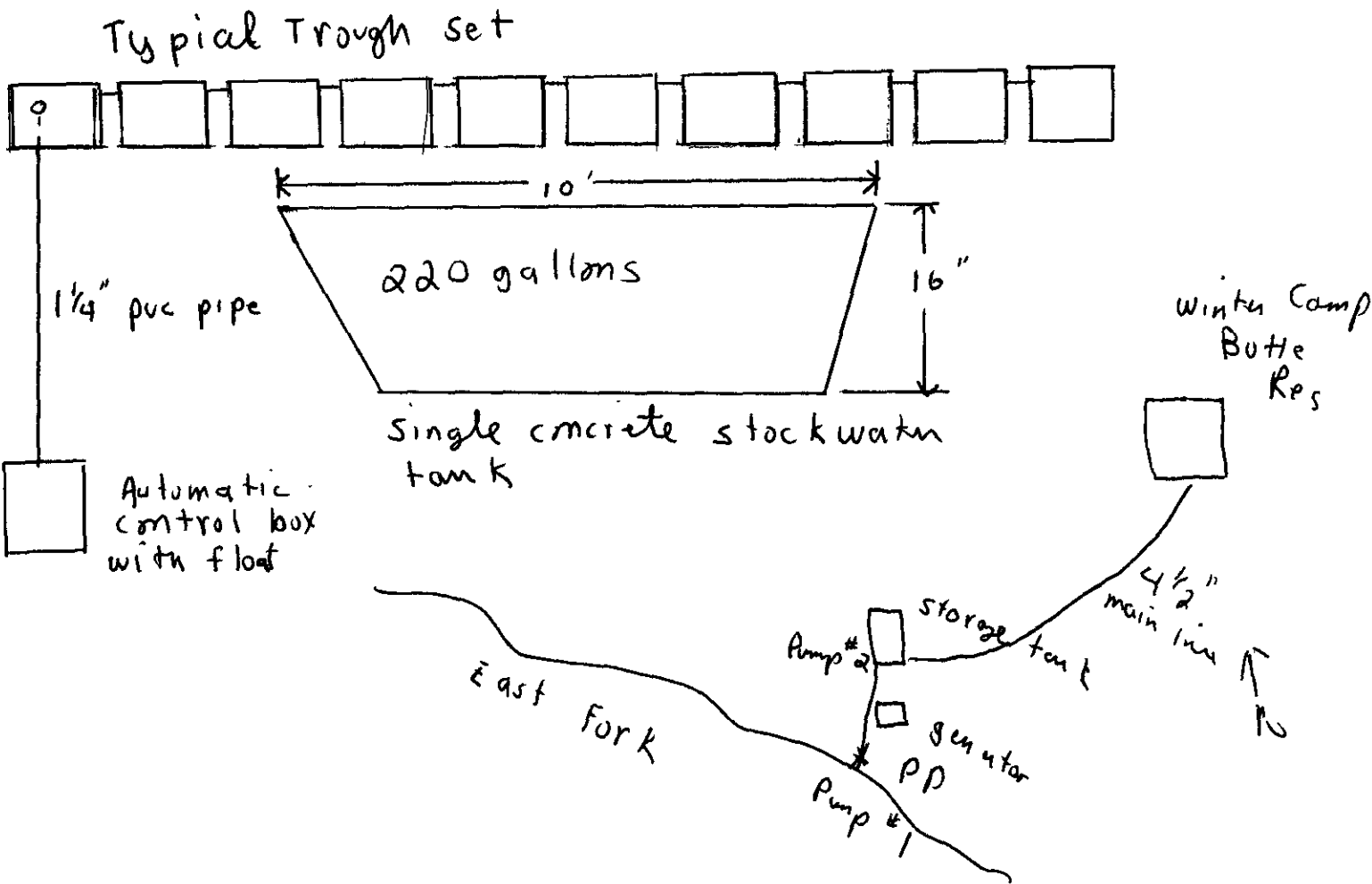

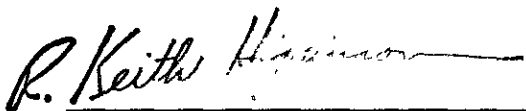

One of the conditions of approval of your water Permit No. 51-7056 (see last page of your approved permit) was that evidence of the extent of development be submitted as proof of application of water to beneficial use to this office on or before October 1, 1972. Enclosed is an affidavit form which must be used to submit the required proof of beneficial use.

If you have not fully completed your project, and you have not previously received an extension of time, you may request an extension of time provided the delay is for reasonable cause as indicated in Section 42-204, Idaho Code, amended. If you have been prevented from proceeding by a governmental agency or by litigation, more than one extension of time can be granted.

Either the beneficial use affidavit or a request for an extension of time must be received by this Department on or before the above mentioned date, otherwise the permit will lapse and be of no further force or effect.
