CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. The maximum annual volume of water to be diverted under the rights identified herein shall not exceed 2886.4 acre feet.
2. A totalizing flow meter and lockable controlling works of a type acceptable to the Department shall be permanently installed and maintained as part of the diverting works prior to diverting water for fish propagation.
3. The maximum number of acres of land irrigated under the combined rights herein shall not exceed 744 acres.

Before May 1 of each year, the water right holder shall advise the Department of the monthly average surface area of water in storage for the prior fiscal year of May 1 to April 30. The monthly evaporation rates shall be multiplied by the monthly average surface area to determine evaporation volume.

- (a) A reduction of acres irrigated will be made at the rate of 1 acre per 3.5 acre feet of water evaporated to account for water loss.
 - (b) The location and number of acres to be irrigated after the reduction for evaporation loss shall be identified by the water right holder prior to the start of the irrigation season.
5. Violation of the conditions identified herein will be cause for the Department to void the approval of this transfer and cancel permit 51-7277.
