
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

#### CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

## For Transfer of Water Right Nos. 51-2137/2139/2146/2154/2173

- 1. The maximum annual volume of water to be diverted under the rights identified herein shall not exceed 2886.4 acre feet.
- 2. A totalizing flow meter and lockable controlling works of a type acceptable to the Department shall be permanently installed and maintained as part of the diverting works prior to diverting water for fish propagation.
- 3. The maximum number of acres of land irrigated under the combined rights herein shall not exceed 744 acres.
- 4. Evaporation of water in storage shall be determined by using the following rates (feet) per month as identified in Department memo dated 12/11/86:

Before May 1 of each year, the water right holder shall advise the Department of the monthly average surface area of water in storage for the prior fiscal year of May 1 to April 30. The monthly evaporation rates shall be multiplied by the monthly average surface area to determine evaporation volume.

- (a) A reduction of acres irrigated will be made at the rate of 1 acre per 3.5 acre feet of water evaporated to account for water loss.
- (b) The location and number of acres to be irrigated after the reduction for evaporation loss shall be identified by the water right holder prior to the start of the irrigation season.
- 5. Violation of the conditions identified herein will be cause for the Department to void the approval of this transfer and cancel permit 51-7277.
- 6. A portion of the water diverted under rights covered by this transfer will be diverted to storage for irrigation following use of the water for fish propagation under Permit No. 51-7277.

In completing the Notice of proof for publication, the information should be taken from your Permit; including any amendments made in connection with a change of point of diversion or land list, which has been recorded in this department. If changes have been made and no amendments are on record, we advise you request a form for this purpose before your Notice is published.

We enclose Form 36, in duplicate, which is to be filled out and returned to this department at least FORTY (40) DAYS BEFORE THE MENTIONED DATE, (allowing for four weeks publication). Please give the name of the town, the address of the place where the depositions will be executed, and, the name of the notary public before whom you will appear to make the depositions of proof (this may be at any place convenient for you and your two witnesses), the quantity of water filed; for what purpose it is used; the point, or points, of diversion; and the location of use or the lands which are irrigated -- all by legal land description.

Enclosed also is Form 11, which is the authorization for us to have the notice published in the designated county newspaper at your expense. This is to be returned with two Forms 36,

At the time we send the notice to the newspaper we will send to you the forms for the depositions of holder and two disinterested witnesses. It is important that the depositions be executed at the time, on the date set, at the place named, and before the notary public, as advertised in the publication notice.
