Please give the name of the town, the address of the place where the depositions will be executed, and, the name of the notary public before whom you will appear to make the depositions of proof (this may be at any place convenient for you and your two witnesses), the quantity of water filed; for what purpose it is used; the point, or points, of diversion; and the location of use or the lands which are irrigated -- all by legal land description.

Enclosed also is Form 11, which is the authorization for us to have the notice published in the designated county newspaper at your expense. This is to be returned with two Forms 36.

At the time we send the notice to the newspaper we will send to you the forms for the depositions of holder and two disinterested witnesses. It is important that the depositions be executed at the time, on the date set, at the place named, and before the notary public, as advertised in the publication notice.

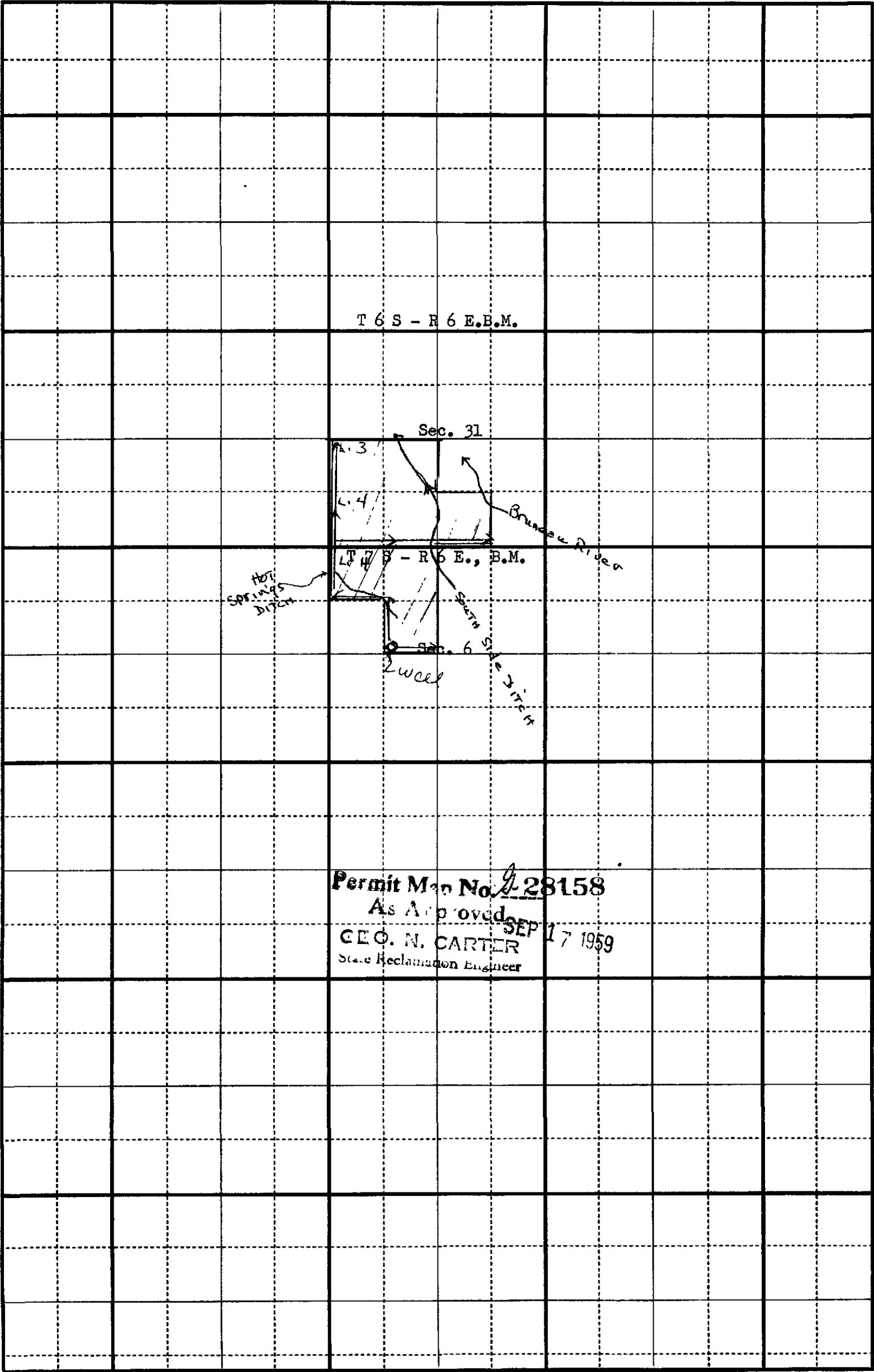
