Affidavit for Change of Point of Diversion of Decreed Water Right

William Turner, being first duly sworn, deposes and says: That his postoffice address is Bruneau, Idaho; That he is the owner of and using a certain water right, bearing date of priority of Apr. 1, 1876; Apr. 1, 1897; Apr. 1, 1905, for 2 1/2, 1 1/2, and 1 cubic feet per second of the waters of Bruneau River, County of Owyhee, State of Idaho, decreed to William Turner, by decree of Judge , of the Third Judicial District of the State of Idaho, in and for the County of Ada, in the case of Grand View Irrigation District, Plaintiff vs. Bruneau Reclamation Corporation Ditch Co., et al, Defendants, said decree bearing date of February 14, 1925, for the purpose of irrigating the following described lands, situate, lying and being in Water Dist. No. 5713, in the County of Owyhee, and State of Idaho, to-wit: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 31, SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 32 Township 6 North N 1/2 NW 1/4 Sec. 5, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 6 Township 7 South all of Range 6 East, Boise Meridian.

That he is the person (or representative of the corporation) to whom such right was issued, (or has become the owner thereof in the following manner: Court decree

That said waters ~~are now~~ ^{were} diverted from said stream in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 5, Twp. 7 S, Range 6 E RM, and conducted to the above described lands through ~~the~~ a private ditch, ~~as per map filed herewith and of this affidavit made a part;~~

That affiant desires to change the point of diversion of said water from the point above described to a point located in NE 1/4 of SW 1/4, Sec. 5, Twp. 7 S, Range 6 E, and thereafter conduct same to the above described land through the South Side ditch, ~~as per map above referred to:~~

That his reasons for desiring to make such change are as follows: The South Side Bruneau Canal Company, Limited has built its point of diversion at the point of diversion formerly used by the affiant

That no one will be injured by such change and that such change will be made at affiant's own risk.
