**Re:** Phone Conversation with Jack Post – Response to IDWR Letter

---

On this date Jack Post contacted me regarding the pending NOV that he received from IDWR dated June 1, 2004. Post said that the 144 irrigated acres in question are actually irrigated under a portion of water right 02-2269. Post said that he leased a portion of this right from a Terry Ketterling, another user within the South Elmore Irrigation Company (SEIC). Post said that he, Ketterling and SEIC have been working with Mark Larson of IDWR on the SEIC service area boundary and place of use for the SRBA adjudication claims and recommendations. Post said that Mark was including the 144 acres in question within the SEIC area, and that Mark had advised that a transfer would not be necessary. Post also said the land from which a portion of 02-2269 was moved is now a dairy serviced by a ground water well and water right, and that there had been an approved water right transfer for the dairy and ground water use.

I advised Post that I would speak with Mar Larson to get further information about the place of use and SEIC service area boundaries. I advised that the explanation seemed reasonable but we would have to check our records further with Mark.
