

# NOTICE OF EXISTING WATER PERMIT

Notice is hereby given that D. O. Morin, P.O. Dear Mr. Morin:

During the 1967 session of the Idaho Legislature, certain amendments were made in the law pertaining to the procedures for making proof of beneficial use of water. In order for the Department to comply with these changes, Rules of Practice and Procedure were adopted on August 1, 1968. Generally, these procedures and the amended law make it simpler for a person to make proof and relieve the permit holder from making separate proofs of completion of works and beneficial use of water.

The enclosed order modifies your permit to comply with those rules and regulations. As a part of the new procedure, you will be required to publish a notice at your expense for two consecutive weeks in a paper as prescribed by the Department, stating that you have been issued a permit and are now submitting proof of beneficial use. Previously, a permit holder had to publish a notice for four weeks when he submitted proof under his permit.

If you will complete the enclosed forms, we will cause the notice to be published. Should you require additional forms or information, we will be glad to supply it upon request at any time.



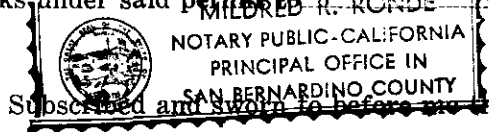

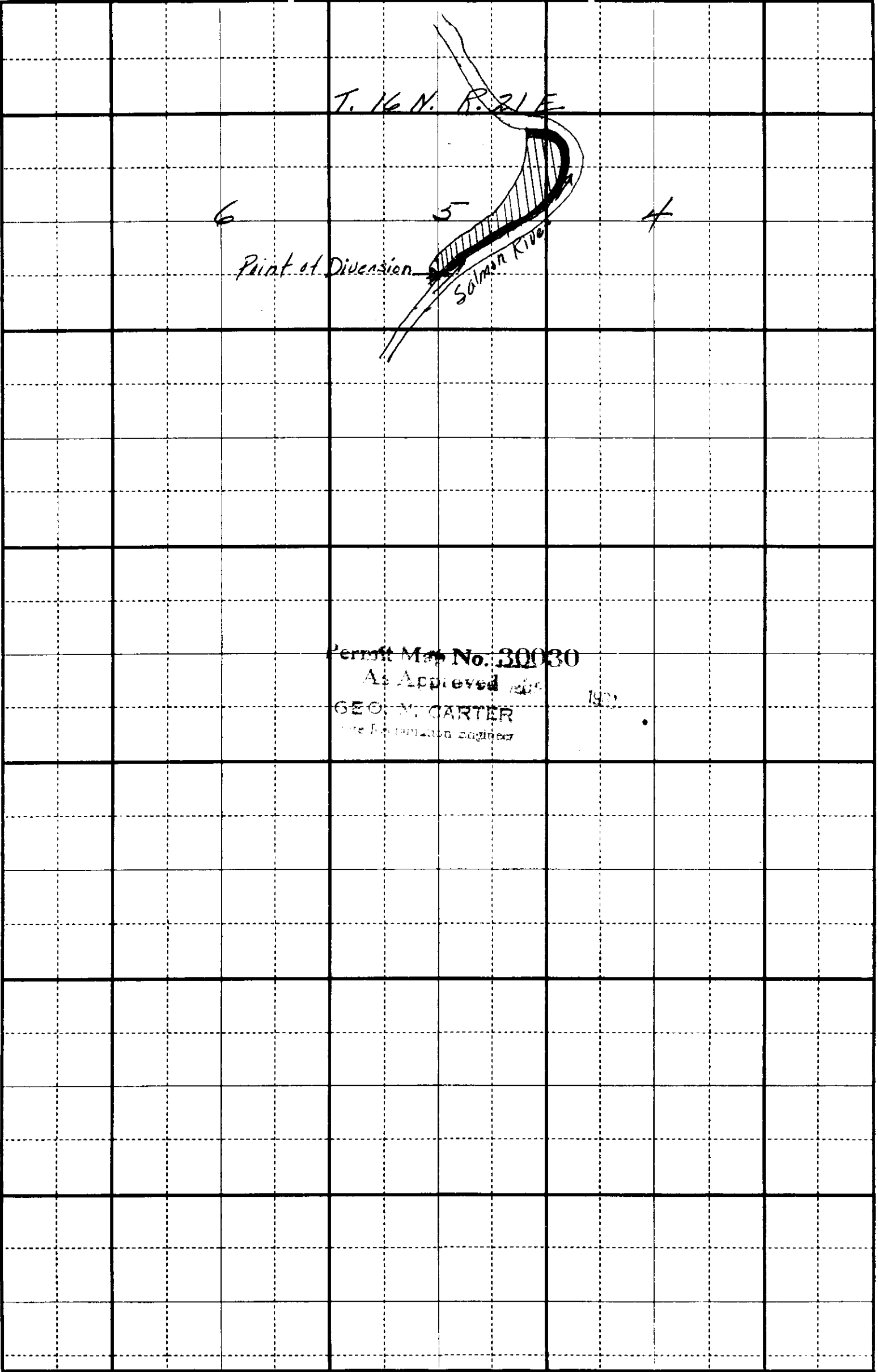
