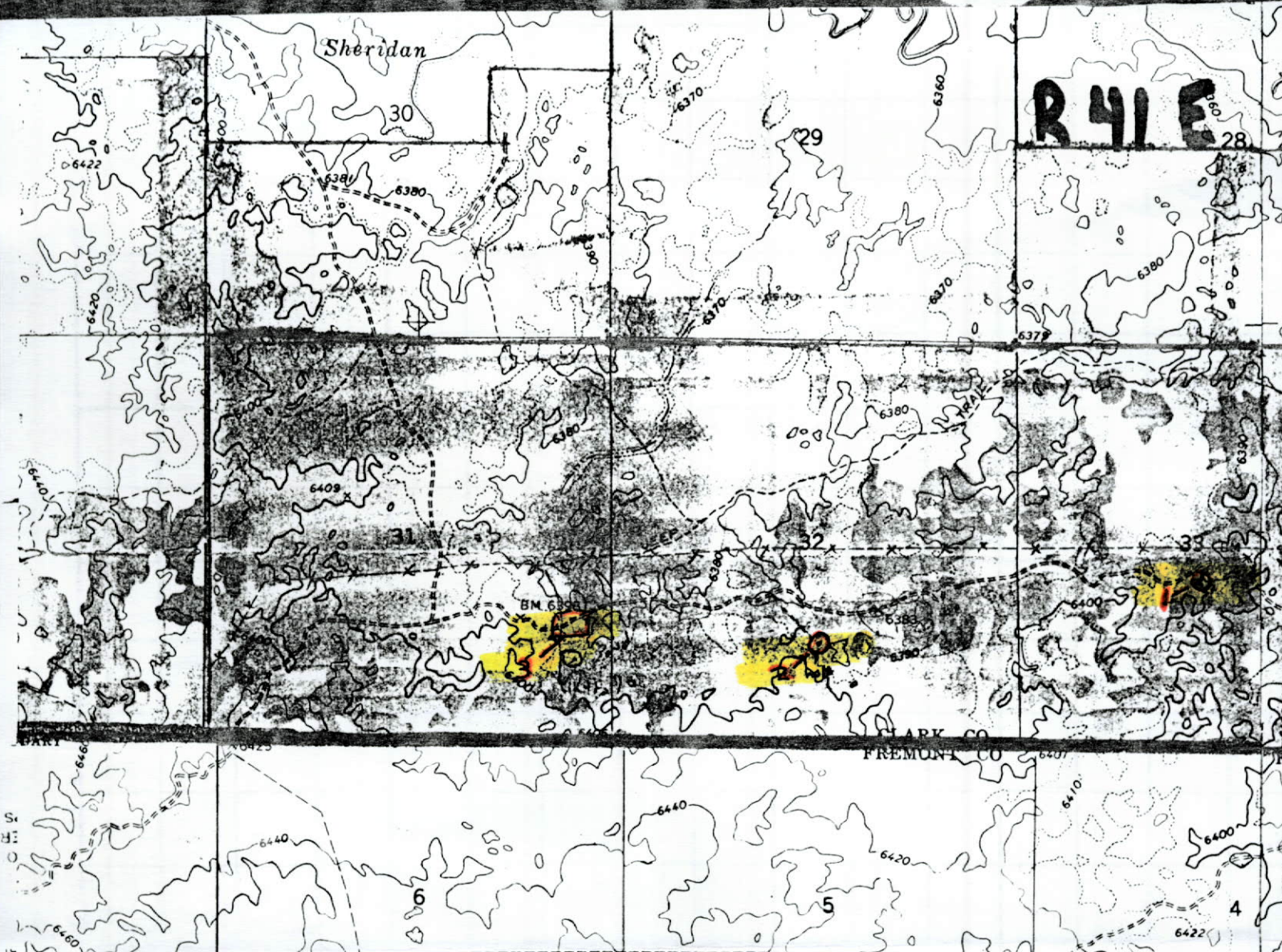

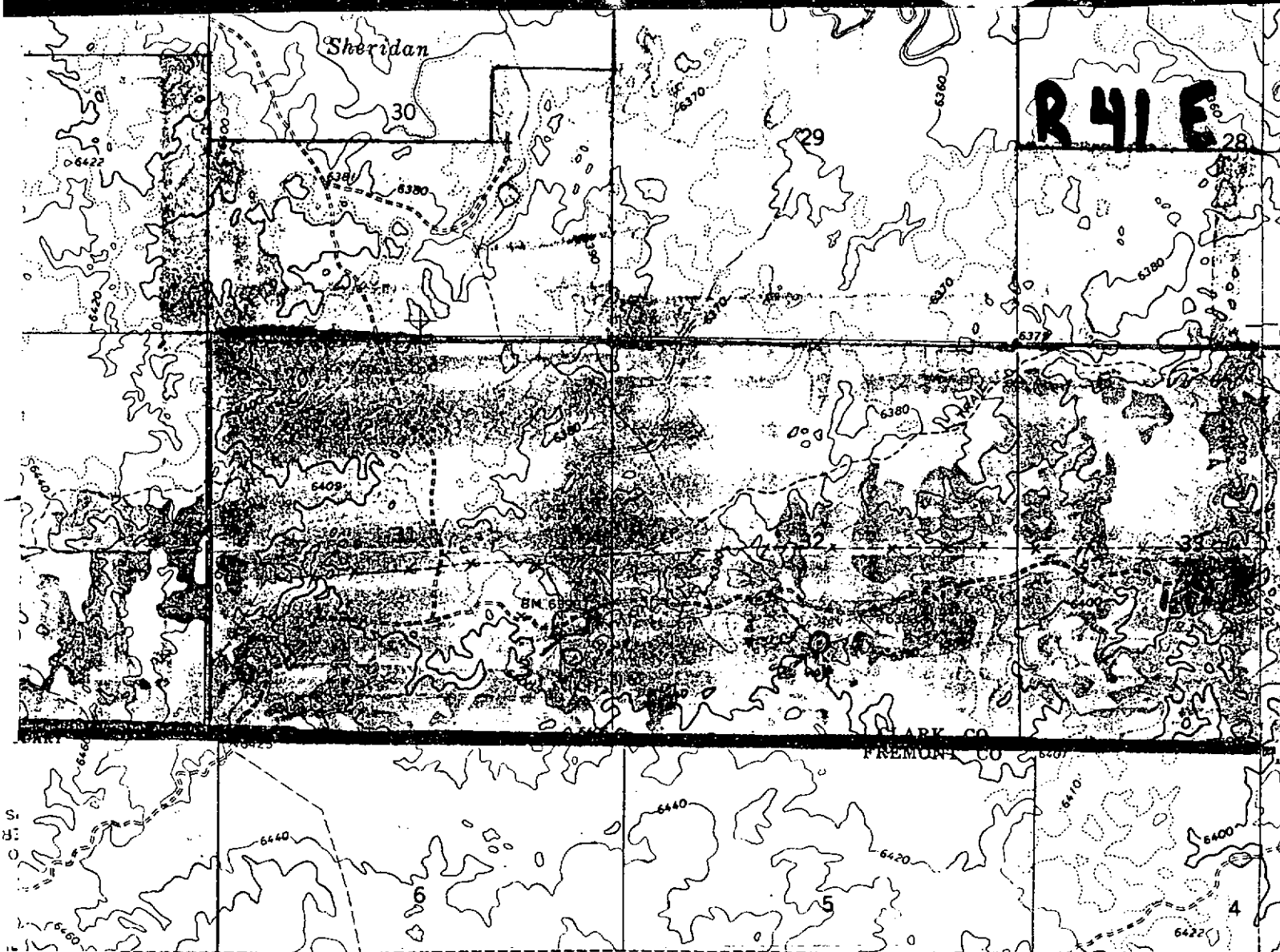

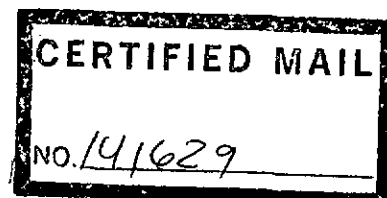

The Department of Water Resources acknowledges receipt of your water right permit. This office is currently in the process of advertising the application in the Post Register on 10-7 & 14-93. The advertisement will be published for two consecutive weeks, and a period of ten days following the second publication will be allowed for the submittal of protests.

If the application is protested, you will be sent a copy of the protest. The protest must be resolved before the application is approved or denied. If the protest is not resolved voluntarily, this Department will conduct a conference and/or hearing on the matter.
