



**NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGE TO WATER RIGHTS**

Notice is hereby given that an Application for Transfer has been filed with the Idaho Department of Water Resources for changes to water rights within Minidoka County:

A & B IRRIGATION DIST., PO BOX 675, RUPERT, IDAHO 83350 filed Application No. 70857 on 12/8/2003. This transfer proposes to add seven wells to a system presently consisting of 178 wells. The system is covered by 12 water rights which total 1100 cfs for irrigation of 66,696.2 acres. Two of the new wells will be drilled but 5 already exist as injection wells that will be converted to production wells. These wells are being added to maintain overall production capacity of the A & B Irrigation District system.

The wells to be added are located as follows:

NENESW S3 T9S, R22E; NENESE S26, T8S, R23E; NWSWSW S14, T8S, R23E; NESENE S21, T8S, R23E; SENWNW S11, T8S, R23E; NENWNW S8, T8S, R24E; SESWSE S9, T8S, R24E; all in Minidoka County. Protests may be submitted based on the criteria of Sec 42-222, Idaho Code. The protestant must also send a copy of the protest to the applicant.
